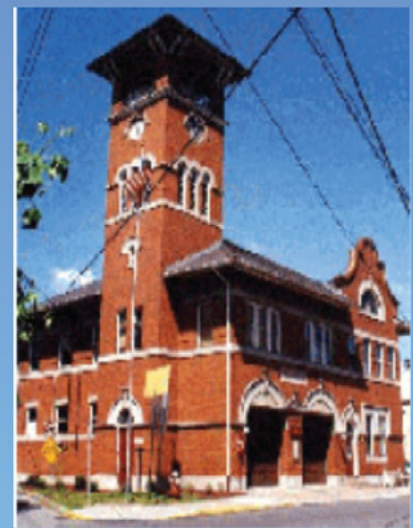

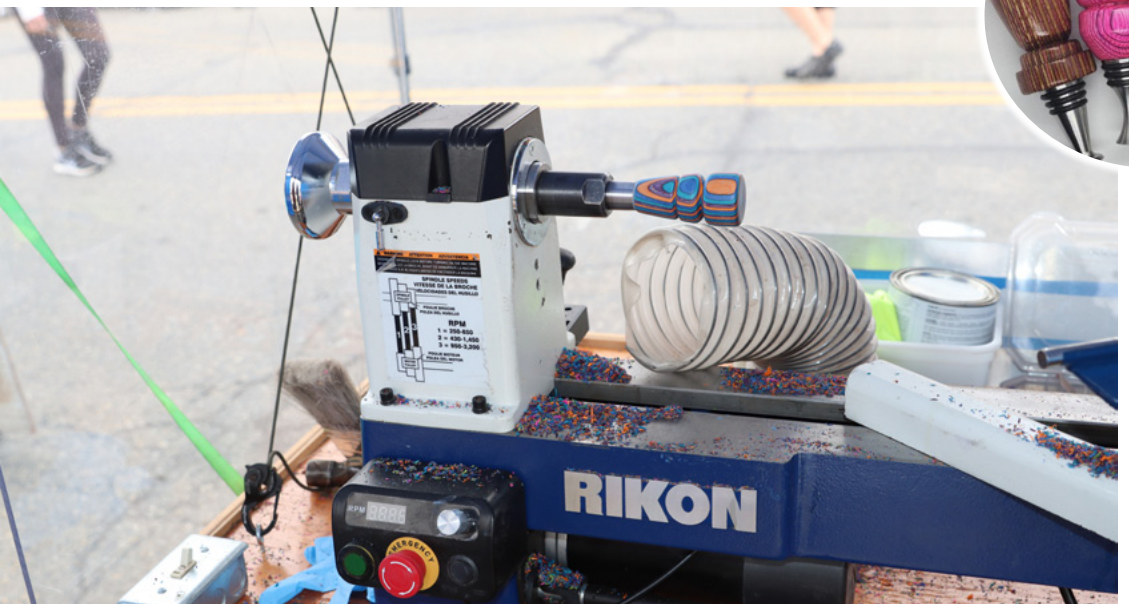

# How To Make The Most Of Your Vacation

Nearly Half Of Respondents Said Their Vacations Lived Up To — Or Exceeded — their expectations.

**L**ess than half of American travelers found that their last vacation lived up to expectations, according to new research.

That was revealed in a survey of 2,000 Americans who have traveled internationally in the past five years, which found only 45% of respondents' vacations lived up to — or exceeded — the perfect picture they'd painted in their minds.

Social media is at least in part to blame, as 72% believe that it contributed to unrealistic expectations for travel.

But respondents also admit their own role in this: 67% said their own planning has led them to be disappointed while traveling for leisure.

Commissioned by Exodus Travels, and conducted by OnePoll, the survey looked at respondents' travel expectations and explored tips on how to make the most of every trip.

For about one-third (31%), finding the destination didn't match expectations impacted their entire trip.

But many didn't let that get them down, as 51% admit they got past their initial disappointment and didn't let it impact their entire trip.

Furthermore, 74% were confident they'd still be able to make the most of a trip that didn't go as planned.

In fact, most respondents (55%) choose to stay calm, making the most of their circumstances, while 49% stay flexible and adapt to the new situation.

Many respondents are doing what they sought to do — they're traveling to see and experience new things (40%), create memories (40%) and escape their daily routine (37%).

"Incredible vacations don't just happen by chance. Making the most of precious time away in new places takes knowhow, experience and incredible planning," said Katy Rockett, Director of Growth at Exodus Travels, which was voted Best Operator in National Geographic's Reader Awards.

The survey also asked respondents about their future travel plans and



anything they're doing to avoid disappointment on upcoming trips.

Interestingly, 87% of those with trips planned for later in the year are taking steps to make the most of their next vacation.

This involves learning about the history and story of the places they're visiting (35%), learning some words in the local language (35%) and using information from local experts who know more than the guidebook (34%).

Respondents also think traveling with an itinerary planned by someone who's an expert in the area (33%) would help prevent disappointment.

"Most of the time I see expectations surpassed," said Rockett. "We're on a mission to make vacations better, and that is very much to do with the presence of an expert local guide and brilliant itineraries, as they are the secret to creating memorable experiences. I see more and more people now choosing to travel this way."

- Use information from local experts who know more than the guidebook — 34%
- Travel with an itinerary planned by someone who's an expert in the area — 33%

- Do more research before traveling — 33%
- Have backup plans in case anything goes wrong — 31%
- Plan the trip with a tour group or travel guide — 31%
- Better plan the sights they want to see — 27%
- Travel with a local tour guide — 26%
- Travel as part of a small group trip — 25%





# Heritage Center Service Clubs Exhibit Opens to Public April 22

“Centuries of Service: A Salute to Slate Belt Service Clubs” opens to the public Saturday, April 22, from 12 – 3 pm at the Slate Belt Heritage Center.

Service is people helping people without any expectation of reward. The new show follows the growth of service clubs, from the mutual benefit societies that only aided members, to the 20th century clubs that gave men, women, boys, and girls a voice and promoted good citizenship, to today’s national organizations that are open to all.

You’ll discover why people formed these clubs, get a glimpse into some of the “secret” early rituals, and connect their causes and mission to the community. From the Knights of the Golden Eagle to the Weona Park Pals, all worked (and played) to serve the Slate Belt.

You can also enjoy refreshed exhibits that feature early Slate Belt History, from the Lenape to the European settlers like the Beck family, to the waves of European immigrants that found employment in the slate, textile and garment industries. The fire-fighting exhibit features antique apparatus from the Slate Belt’s golden industrial age.

This year they collaborate with the Quarry Hoist Group and Totts Gap Art Institute, which will dedicate the new pavilion for the S. Flory Manufacturing Company Hoist in Bethel Park next door the heritage Center on North First St..


The dedication ceremony starts at 11 am and demonstrations will continue through the afternoon. The Heritage Center (adjacent to Bethel Park) will open from 12 - 3, serve light snacks, and have special displays of Flory Manufacturing material. You’ll be able to view a continuous slide show that highlights the life of the hoist from the quarry to its new home.

The Heritage Center will also unveil the new outdoor signage sponsored by a Northampton County Department of Community and Economic Development Hotel Tax Grant. The NPS standard display signs bring Slate Belt history out of the museum and into downtown Bangor.


The Slate Belt Heritage Center is located in the 1907 Town Hall building at 30 North First Street, Bangor, PA. Founded in 1999, the Center is a not-for-profit- 501 (c) 3 that collects, preserves, interprets and makes public the history, ethnic traditions and industrial heritage of the area. SBHC is open Saturdays and Sundays, noon to 3 PM from mid-April through October and Sundays, November through March, noon - 3PM. Tours and research time can be scheduled by appointment.
