# Praying for Maya

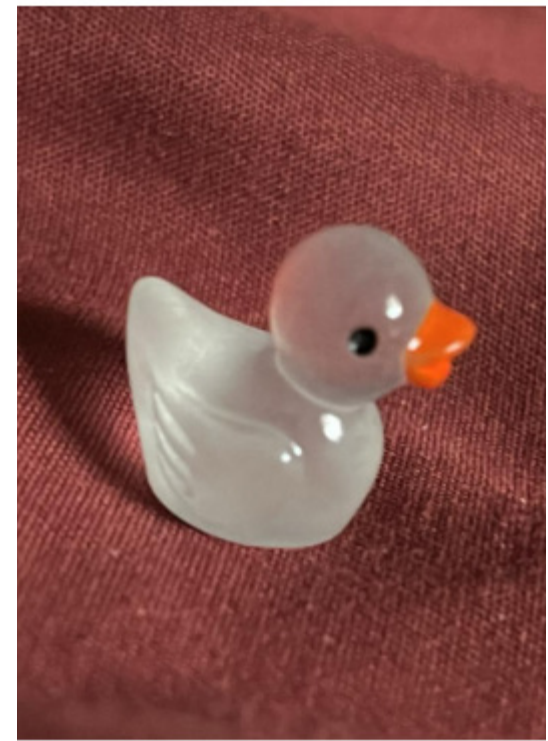

## Boscola Announces \$175,K Grant For Minsi Lake Improvements

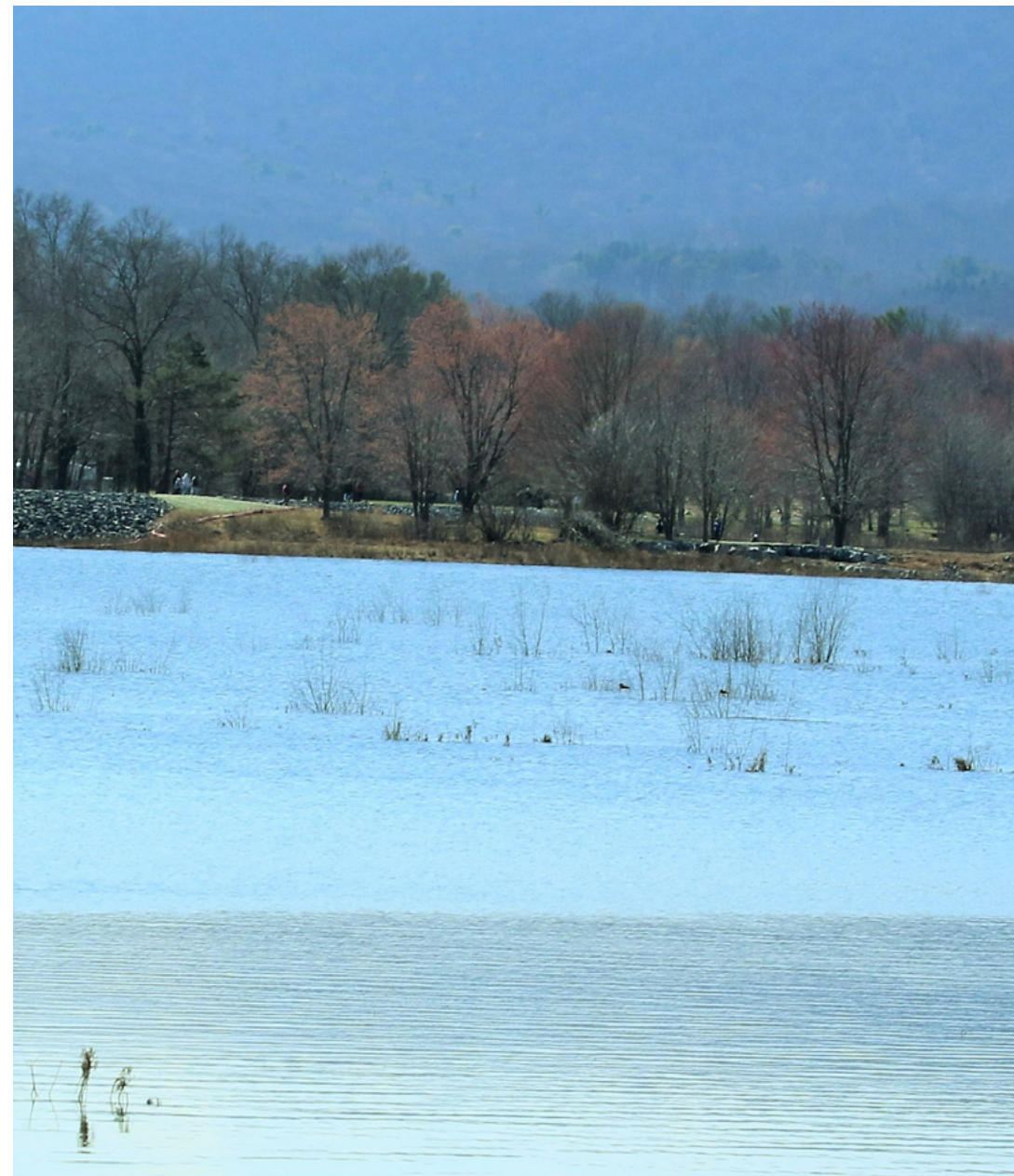
BETHLEHEM (April 24, 2023) – State Senator Lisa M. Boscola announced today that the PA Fish and Boat Commission awarded a \$175,000 Boating Facility Grant to Northampton County for the Minsi Lake Access project, specifically for improvements to the boat launch area.

“Minsi Lake is a tremendous asset to the Slate Belt and all of Northampton County and this Boating Facility Grant will allow Northampton County to make important improvements to the boat launch on the east side of the lake,” Senator Boscola stated. “Recreational opportunities will be enhanced for Northampton County residents and visitors to the Slate Belt through this state funding.”

Northampton County will be using the grant funds to design and construct new restrooms, an improved parking area with ADA parking spaces, an ADA accessible trail connecting all the amenities, and install solar lighting to the existing parking area on the east side of the reservoir.

Northampton County's overall project to improve Minsi Lake also includes plans to construct a pedestrian bridge across the spillway of the dam to connect the facilities on west side of the lake to those on the east side. An adaptive canoe/kayak launch exists on the east side of Minsi Lake, for which The Friends of Minsi Lake provides adaptive paddling programs for people of all abilities at this location.

Funds for the Boating Facility Grant program are derived primarily from boat registration fees, state motorboat fuels tax, restricted revenue accounts, and when available, through various Federal assistance or grant awards.

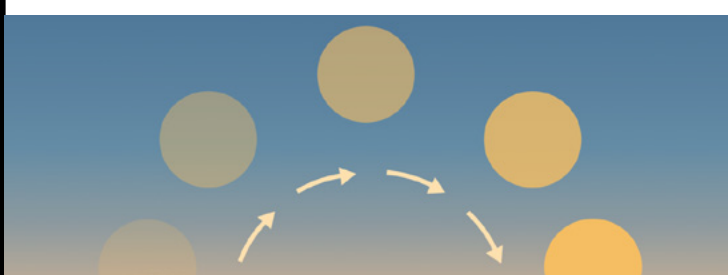

# Quarry Hoist Vital to the Success of the Slate Industry

A hoist that was used in the Jackson Slate Quarry in Pen Argyl and was manufactured by S. Flory Manufacturing Co in Bangor circa 1907, found its way to Bethlehem to be a temporary part of the National Museum of Industrial History. The the Jackson Quarry hoist, however, is now in its permanent site next to the Slate Belt Heritage Center.

Thanks to historian Mike Piersa and friend of the Slate Belt Heritage Center, he was a force in bringing the hoist back home.

The Bangor Borough Council approved the use of Bethel Park adjacent to the Slate Belt Heritage center at the corner of Market and First streets as a site for the hoist which was officially dedicated last Saturday.

.Hoists were crucial to the success of mining slate. Quarries are huge holes in the ground and product can only be removed vertically. There are no horizontal shafts where rails can be used for transport.

The Jackson hoist weighs 28,000 pounds and can lift 5-8 tons of slate out of the quarry.

Considering the number of quarries dug in the Bangor-Pen Argyl area, numerous hoists were necessary to quarry Slate. S. Flory manufacturing owned by Solomon Flory on Main Street in Bangor at the site of the current CVS, was conveniently located for local quarry owners. The Flory company made, serviced and repaired the hoists in addition to other quarry machinery.

The company at its productive peak employed over 500 people and sold hoists and other industrial machinery nationwide. It has been estimated that the company made 7,000 machines before going out of business during the Great Depression.

A fire in 1913 at the Flory Company caused damages of \$1,000,000 ( \$20,000,000 in today's money) made news around the country, including a mention in the New York Times.

People unfamiliar with Slate may view the quarry remains in the area as unsightly, but when one considers the success of the Slate Industry and S. Flory Manufacturing, those piles of Slate serve as a vestige of a great era in Slate Belt history.

The display of the Jackson hoist will help keep that memory alive.

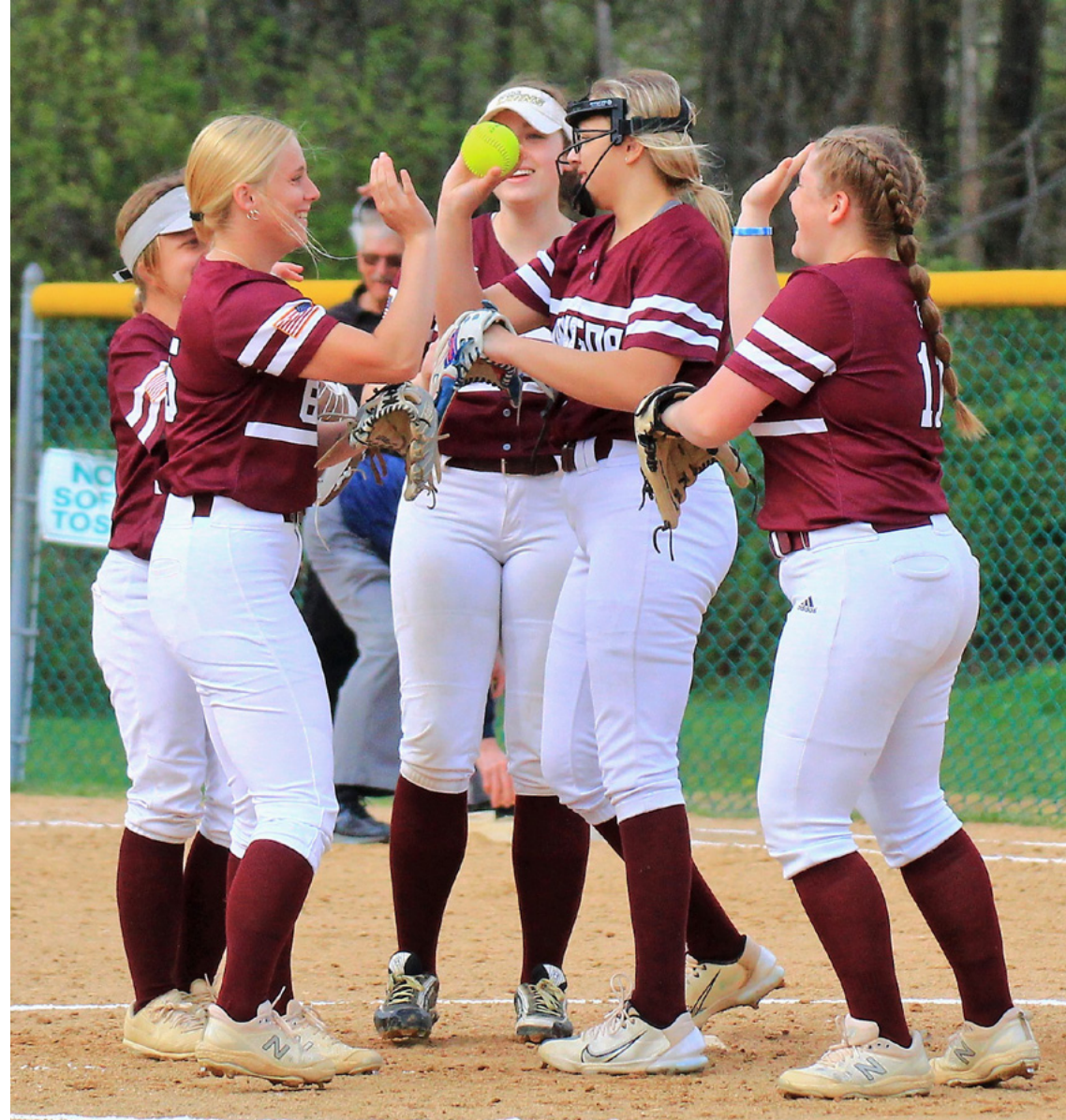

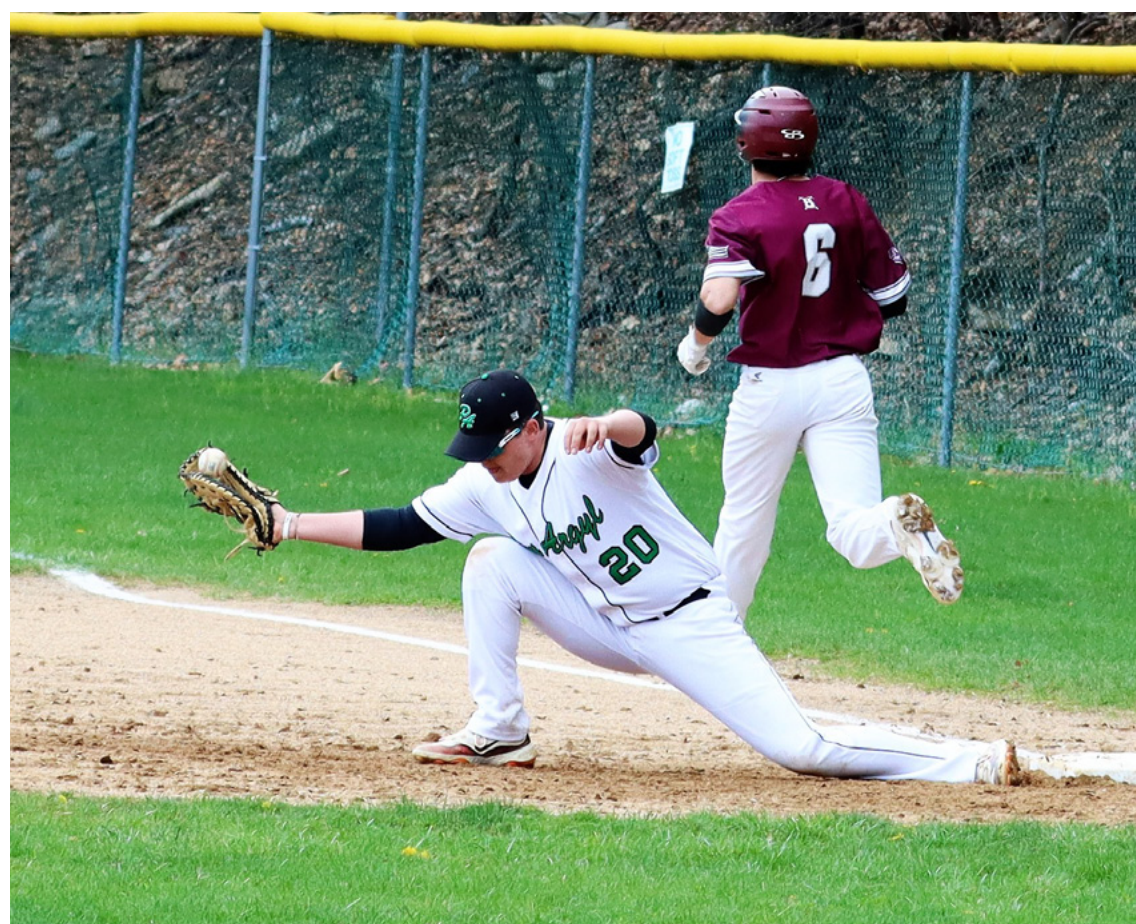

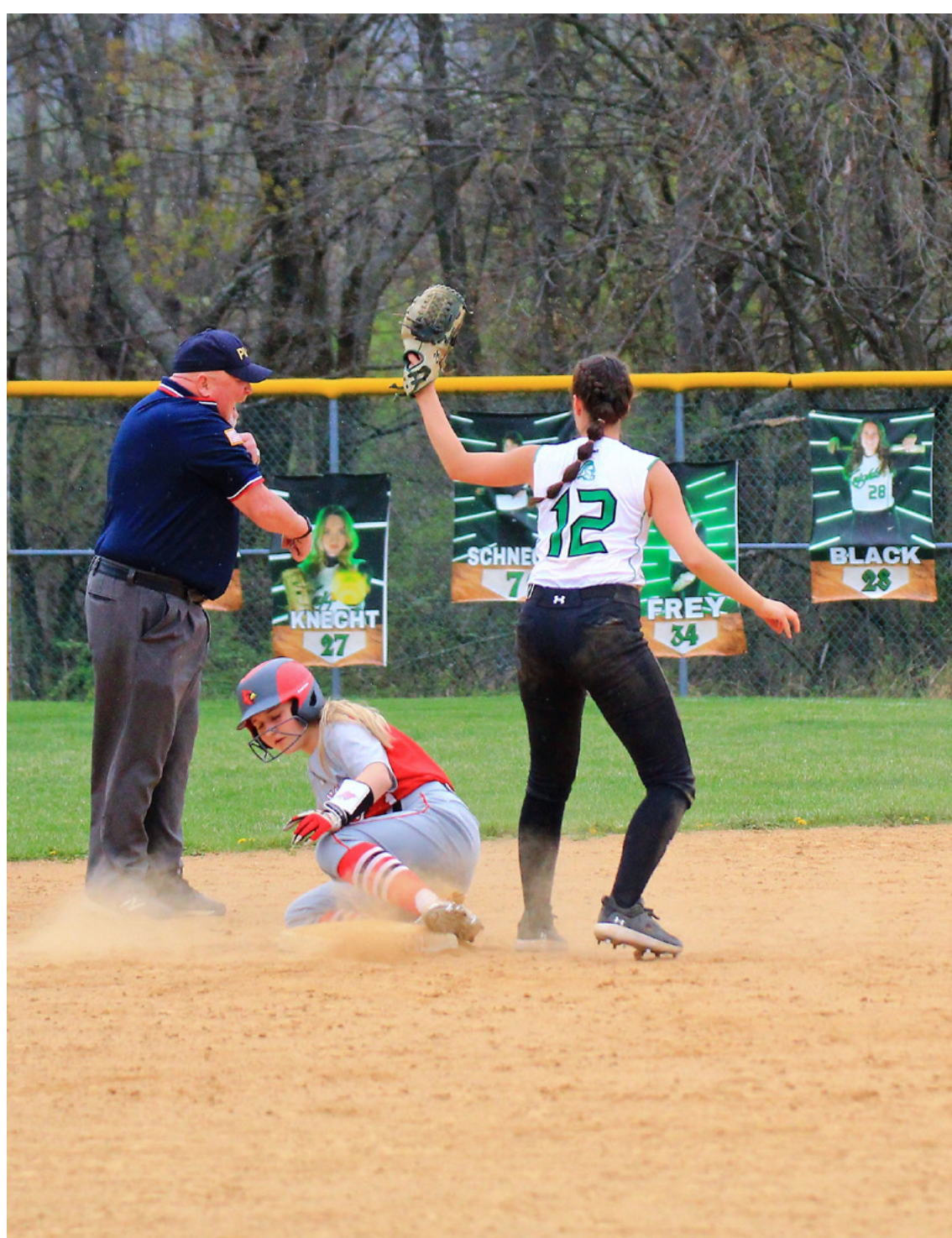
