Boscola Introduces Open Primary Legislation

Harrisburg, PA –April 26, 2023– Senators Lisa M. Boscola (D-Northampton) and Dan Laughlin (R-Erie) today introduced a bipartisan proposal to repeal closed primary elections in Pennsylvania, allowing registered voters who selected 'none' or 'no affiliation' on their voter registration form to exercise their voting rights during a primary election.

"Most Pennsylvanian's are not aware that if they do not register Democratic or Republican, you will likely be turned away on primary election day," Boscola said. "It is shameful because not everyone can identify within the two-party system we currently have. That choice shouldn't silence their vote."

This bill will restore voting access to more than 1.2 million voters in Pennsylvania, who identify as 'independent' voters and are not registered to one of the two largest political parties: Democratic and Republican. According to the Pennsylvania Department of State, that number of unaffiliated voters has risen by 51,816 between 2015 and 2021.

"Look outside of Pennsylvania and you will see that most states have open primaries, and it hasn't created chaos. In fact, it empowers more voters and will likely increase voter participation. That's a good thing," Boscola said.

Pennsylvania is 1 of only 9 remaining states that bar independent voters from participating in primaries, according to the National Conference of State Legislatures. These states include Delaware, New York, Florida, Kentucky, Maryland, Nevada, Oregon, and New Mexico. Senate Bill 400 would bring Pennsylvania in line with the majority of states that have modified or open primaries.


"SB 400 isn't some grand scheme to skew primary election results to affect the fall general election outcome. This is simply about engaging the voters and letting them vote. For us to prevent them from doing that, thereby ignoring their opinions and voices, is just wrong. Addressing that wrong is one of the most important things that can be done as a lawmaker," said Laughlin.

Senator Boscola and Laughlin have already gained over a dozen cosponsors from members of both parties in the Senate. However, the issue faces an uphill battle despite broad public support and an increasing majority of the American public who self-describe themselves as Independents. A number believed to be 49% of American voters, according to a Gallup survey in March of 2023.



Quarry Hoist Vital to the Success of the Slate Industry

A hoist that was used in the Jackson Slate Quarry in Pen Argyl and was manufactured by S. Flory Manufacturing Co in Bangor circa 1907, found its way to Bethlehem to be a temporary part of the National Museum of Industrial History. The the Jackson Quarry hoist, however, is now in its permanent site next to the Slate Belt Heritage Center.

Thanks to historian Mike Piersa and friend of the Slate Belt Heritage Center, he was a force in bringing the hoist back home.

The Bangor Borough Council approved the use of Bethel Park adjacent to the Slate Belt Heritage center at the corner of Market and First streets as a site for the hoist which was officially dedicated last Saturday.

.Hoists were crucial to the success of mining slate. Quarries are huge holes in the ground and product can only be removed vertically. There are no horizontal shafts where rails can be used for transport.

The Jackson hoist weighs 28,000 pounds and can lift 5-8 tons of slate out of the quarry.

Considering the number of quarries dug in the Bangor-Pen Argyl area, numerous hoists were necessary to quarry Slate. S. Flory manufacturing owned by Solomon Flory on Main Street in Bangor at the site of the current CVS, was conveniently located for local quarry owners. The Flory company made, serviced and repaired the hoists in addition to other quarry machinery.

The company at its productive peak employed over 500 people and sold hoists and other industrial machinery nationwide. It has been estimated that the company made 7,000 machines before going out of business during the Great Depression.

A fire in 1913 at the Flory Company caused damages of \$1,000,000 (\$20,000,000 in today's money) made news around the country, including a mention in the New York Times.

People unfamiliar with Slate may view the quarry remains in the area as unsightly, but when one considers the success of the Slate Industry and S. Flory Manufacturing, those piles of Slate serve as a vestige of a great era in Slate Belt history.

The display of the Jackson hoist will help keep that memory alive.







