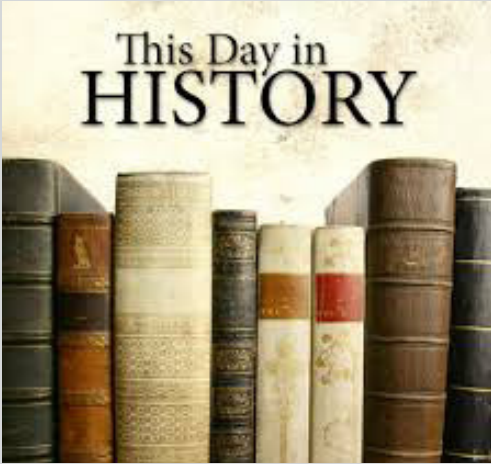
On April 3rd, 1973, the first handheld mobile telephone call was made by an employee of which company?

And the answer: Motorola.

Using a two and a half pound prototype, Motorola employee Martin Cooper placed a call walking between 53rd and 54th streets on Sixth Avenue in New York. He called his rival, Joel Engel of Bell Laboratories.

Before Apple was even an idea in Steve Jobs’ head, a clunky Motorola cellular phone made its first mobile call. The prototype, sometimes familiarly referred to as the “shoe” phone for its size and weight, allowed users to call for 35 minutes before then requiring a 10-hour charge period.

Rock Icon Kurt Cobain Dies



Modern rock icon Kurt Cobain dies by suicide on April 5, 1994. His body was discovered inside his home in Seattle, Washington, three days later by Gary Smith, an electrician, who was installing a security system in the house. Despite indications that Cobain, the lead singer of Nirvana, killed himself, some skeptics questioned the circumstances of his death and pinned responsibility on his wife, Courtney Love.

Cobain’s downward spiral began taking shape in Italy the previous month. He went into a coma and nearly died after mixing champagne and the drug Rohypnol. The public was led to believe that the coma was induced by an accidental heroin overdose, since Cobain had a well-known problem with the drug.

Back at home in Seattle’s Denny-Blaine neighborhood, the police were called to Cobain and Love’s home when he again threatened to kill himself. Although Cobain stated in a 1991 interview that he didn’t believe in guns, the officers confiscated four from his possession. As his wife and friends watched him spin out of control, they attempted to intervene.
