

Bangor Library Farm Jubilee Returns

The 4th Annual Farm Jubilee will take place on Saturday, April 29, from 11 a.m. until 2 p.m. in East Bangor Park. The event, sponsored by the Bangor Public Library and its Board of Trustees, is the library's big fundraiser of the year. Admission is \$5.

Many farm-related venders will be present, including a petting zoo, corn pit, wood spinning, and honeybees and plants. There will also be a basket raffle, as well as food and music.



Heritage Center Service Clubs Exhibit Opens to Public April 22

"Centuries of Service: A Salute to Slate Belt Service Clubs" opens to the public Saturday, April 22, from 12:00 – 3:00 pm at the Slate Belt Heritage Center.

Service is people helping people without any expectation of reward. The new show follows the growth of service clubs, from the mutual benefit societies that only aided members, to the 20th century clubs that gave men, women, boys, and girls a voice and promoted good citizenship, to today's national organizations that are open to all.

You'll discover why people formed these clubs, get a glimpse into some of the "secret" early rituals, and connect their causes and mission to the community. From the Knights of the Golden Eagle to the Weona Park Pals, all worked (and played) to serve the Slate Belt.

You can also enjoy refreshed exhibits that feature early Slate Belt History, from the Lenape to the European settlers like the Beck family, to the waves of European immigrants that found employment in the slate, textile and garment industries. The fire-fighting exhibit features antique apparatus from the Slate Belt's golden industrial age.

This year they collaborate with the Quarry Hoist Group and Totts Gap Art Institute, which will dedicate the new pavilion for the S. Flory Manufacturing Company Hoist in Bethel Park next door the heritage Center on North First St..

The dedication ceremony starts at 11 am and demonstrations will continue through the afternoon. The Heritage Center (adjacent to Bethel Park) will open from 12 - 3, serve light snacks, and have special displays of Flory Manufacturing material. You'll be able to view a continuous slide show that highlights the life of the hoist from the quarry to its new home.

The Heritage Center will also unveil the new outdoor signage sponsored by a Northampton County Department of Community and Economic Development Hotel Tax Grant. The NPS standard display signs bring Slate Belt history out of the museum and into downtown Bangor.

The Slate Belt Heritage Center is located in the 1907 Town Hall building at 30 North First Street, Bangor, PA. Founded in 1999, the Center is a not-for-profit-501 (c) 3 that collects, preserves, interprets and makes public the history, ethnic traditions and industrial heritage of the area. SBHC is open Saturdays and Sundays, noon to 3 PM from mid-April through October and Sundays, November through March, noon - 3PM. Tours and research time can be scheduled by appointment.

Bangor Public Library Book Club Promotes Reading, Relationships

You just finished reading a really good book, and are excited to talk about it with others. The problem is, no one you know has read the book.

The Bangor Library Book Club can solve that problem.

"Book Club is a great opportunity to meet new people and be exposed to a variety of books in a welcoming environment," club member Krystal Ditzig says.

The club meets the first Tuesday of each month on the second floor of the library from 6:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. All are welcome.

The club's reading list is developed from member recommendations. Members vote on which books to add to the reading list. The result is a diverse collection of fiction and non-fiction genres, including books you might not have otherwise read.

Recent book club selections include "The Measure" by Nikki Erlick, "The Maid" by Nita Prose, and "The Midnight Library" by Matt Haig. Each member whose recommendation is selected hosts that month's discussion. Questions circulated via email prior to the meeting help foster lively and informative discussions.

"I have discovered through our discussions that there are often perspectives that I would never have thought of if I simply read the books alone," club member Laraine Reedy says.

In addition to promoting lifelong learning, participation in a book club helps build new relationships. Light refreshments may be brought to monthly meetings, creating a relaxing environment where opinions are shared and horizons are broadened.

Book club member Judy Cannavo quotes American writer and critic Edmund Wilson: "No two persons ever read the same book."


"It's true," Cannavo says. "I really enjoy learning about other readers' unique perspectives at book club meetings."
