* **ADDITIONAL DETAILS...**The most oppressive heat and humidity is forecast to occur Thursday. The period of hot and humid conditions will likely continue through Friday.

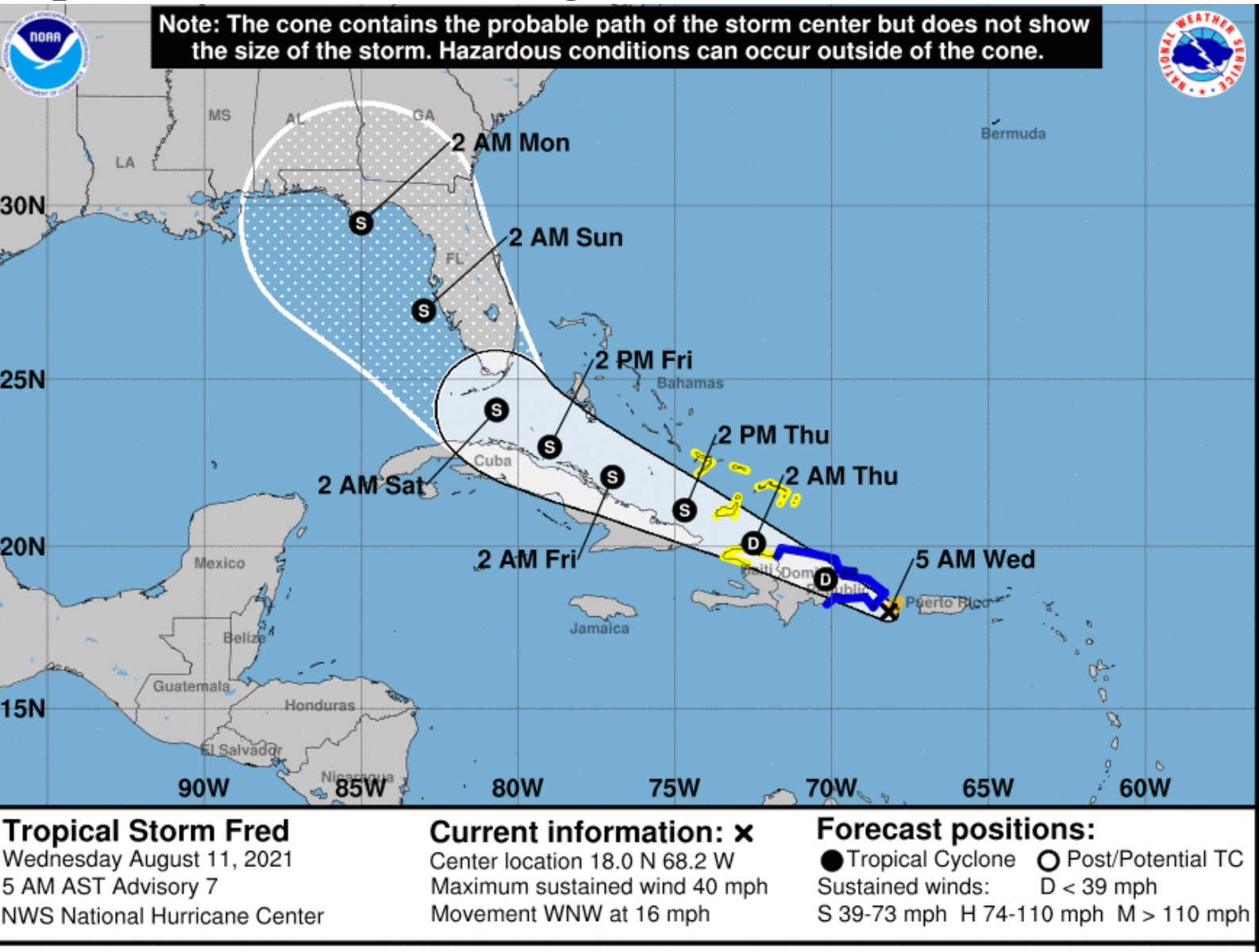

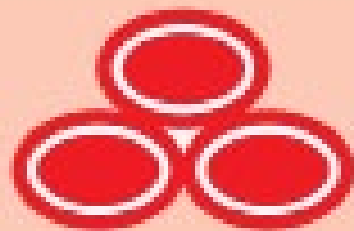
