

The Perfect Wedding Photos Cost Americans This Much

A majority believe it's important to look good for their wedding photos

S even in 10 married Americans said they couldn't even enjoy their wedding day because of how stressed they were over their own appearance.

A poll of 2,000 engaged or married Americans found on average, brides and grooms are willing to spend \$1,680 on a good wedding photographer and an additional \$1,581 on just getting ready for the photos themselves.

Four out of five (79%) believe it's important to have the perfect wedding photos and 68% believe it's important to look good for their wedding photos.

A quarter (24%) planned to have aesthetic changes done leading up to their big day.

Leading up to their picture debut, respondents said they plan or had planned to get their hair professionally done (56%), get their makeup done (45%), get their nails done (41%), lose weight (27%) and get their teeth whitened (26%).

However, the study commissioned by the Invisalign brand and conducted by OnePoll, found the lead-up to their wedding day rarely comes scot-free. Four in five (81%) said they feel or felt some level of stress leading up to their wedding day.

Weddings are so chaotic that sometimes even photoshoots don't go smoothly.

Over a fourth of married respondents (29%) experienced some kind of drama during their wedding photoshoot — including wedding party members running late (37%), in-laws or parents disagreeing on who should be in family photos (37%) and kids making faces (32%).

A third (33%) also stated they didn't show their teeth in any of their wedding photos because they were embarrassed by their smile.

When looking at other peoples' wedding photos, 40% said the first physical feature they look at is their smile

"Wedding days rank high among the most important days a person can experience in their life, and one of the milestones that bring patients into my office for a consultation," said orthodontist Dr. Marta Baird, DDS, MSD. "Knowing you're going to look great for photos that will be treasured for generations is so important to many of my patients who are planning a wedding."








Mom Scrambles To Save Kids After Baby Monitor Explodes

Baby monitor, which was on the kitchen counter, started "hissing" and smoking.

She grabbed 1-year-old daughter Bonnie, who was asleep upstairs, and her son

Joey, 3, and dashed outside their home in Rugby, Warks.

Meanwhile, her mom Carmen, 51, smothered the burning device in a towel and threw it outside.

The Hello Baby monitor that combusted in Shannon's home. The fire broke out last Tuesday, Aug. 1, two weeks after Shannon bought the ± 39.99 (\$50.87 USD) monitor from Amazon.

She says if the monitor had exploded while the family were asleep, the outcome could have been tragic.

She said: "It was a terrifying experience.

"The monitor was in the kitchen. It had fallen forwards by itself and was making a sort of hissing noise.

"Smoke was coming out of it really fast and filled the downstairs of my house within seconds. It smelled absolutely awful.

The burned baby monitor.

"It just happened really fast, it was like a whistling kettle.

"I told my mom the monitor was on fire and I thought it might really explode like you see electric bikes sometimes do.

"The kitchen was completely filled with smoke and it was filled with a smell of burning plastic.

"My mom quickly wrapped the burning monitor in a towel and chucked i t i n t h e garden."

The fire a n d scorched the kitchen worktop photos show the melted remains of the monitor. Shannon complained

to the manufacturers Hello Baby but says they just emailed her offering to refund her the money.

She said: "The monitor burned my kitchen worktop and would no doubt have caused a serious fire had the circumstances been different.

"We emailed the company and they replied with a very non sympathetic offer of a refund and 'sorry for the inconvenience'.

"It looks like the battery exploded in it. We emailed the company and explained what had happened.

"The first email was that they wanted the Amazon number and to offer a refund.

"They sent me back some certificates from testing saying it theoretically shouldn't happen.

"I was there and I saw it so we could take action quickly. We used that monitor every night and asleep. It's often on a carpet.

"We're unlucky that it happened but lucky it happened when and where it did.

"It burnt the kitchen worktop where it was. The danger was had I not been in there it would have escalated into a fire very quickly."

Shannon Makepeace, her partner Paul Farrington and children Bonnie and Joey.

Shannon's mom Carmen said: "We believe the battery exploded.

"It was in use but not plugged into the mains.

"Luckily Shannon heard it bang and we were able to get the burning unit out of the house after only a few seconds.

"The whole downstairs filled with awful, acrid smoke.

"It was so scary but we feel lucky. The situation could've been a lot worse." Hello Baby and Amazon have not responded to SWNS' requests for comment.

How This Mom Lost Half Her Body Weight "My Health Is More Important Than How I Look In A Swimsuit."

A mom ditched her daily three-course dinners to lose half her body weight – and is now swallowed by her wedding dress.

Jennifer Brown, 41, says she has always struggled with her weight and tipped the scales a 342 lbs and wore a U.S. size 24 at her biggest.

After being diagnosed with gestational diabetes when she was pregnant she decided she needed to make a change.

But she struggled to ditch her regular Mcdonald's lunches and three course dinners until a health check up revealed high blood sugar levels.

She kept a food diary and cut out fizzy drinks and large portions and lost 89lbs. She then started taking weight loss drug Mounjaro - also known as Tirzepatide to help her shift the extra pounds.

Now a slender 175 lbs and a US size 10, Jennifer's wedding dress dwarfs her. Jennifer, abstractor, from Des Moines, Iowa, said: "I've lost an entire person from my body.

"I've tired on tops that barely fit me before – now they are like a dress on me. "I can't believe that I'm here.

"I have a couple of core memories on my wedding day when I looked at my reflection and said out loud to myself how beautiful I felt.

"And that's all that matters. But I am healthier now.

"My health is more important than how I look in a swimsuit."

Jennifer feared she might not be able to look after her son, Maddox, nine and step-daughter, Cameron, 21, after she was told she had high blood sugars in 2019.

Her husband, Jeff, 46, a shift supervisor at an ethanol refinery, had a heart attack aged 41 which gave Jennifer another boost to make a change.

The mom had often been coming home to a meal of steak, potatoes, salad with ranch dressing, bread and ice cream but switched this to healthy meals such as a pork chop and vegetables.



Jennifer said: "I was a binge eater.

"I would eat out of boredom or emotionally.

"I never felt the feeling of fullness or satisfaction.

"I could go to a restaurant and eat an appetizer, main, desert and still be able to have something later.

"I basically had a three course meal every dinner."

She lost 89lbs by learning to eat healthy and started walking as much as she could but struggled to shift any more weight.

Jennifer turned to the weight loss drug Mounjaro which has helped her slim down to 175lbs.

She said: "I've never been a size 10 - even in middle school.

"I got on a plane and I didn't have to worry about asking for a seat belt extender." Jennifer has also taken up running as part of her daily workouts and can now run 5k.

She said: "I can run miles.

"I can climb mountains.

"I get to play catch with my son and be present in his life.

"I'm showing him it matter to take care of yourself."

Jennifer doesn't deprive herself of a sweet treat when she is craving it but will get a smaller pot of ice cream instead of her previous order -a hot fudge sundae, with brownie and cherries on top.

She said: "I try to keep really balanced."

Jennifer said Jeff has been her "biggest supporter" throughout her journey and she has 10lbs left to lose before she is at her goal weight.


