

Plonking kids in front of the TV for hours on end paves the way for heart attacks and strokes in later life, warns a new study.

Researchers found being a couch potato between childhood and young adulthood is

Dr Andrew Agbaje of the University of Eastern Finland, said: "All those hours of screen time in young people add up to a heavier heart, which we know from studies in adults raises the likelihood of heart attack and stroke.

"Children and teenagers need to move more to protect their long-term health.

"Children were sedentary for more than six hours a day and this increased by nearly three hours a day by the time they reached young adulthood.

"Our study indicates that the accumulation of inactive time is related to heart damage regardless of body weight and blood pressure.

"Parents should encourage children and teenagers to move more by taking them out for a walk and limiting time spent on social media and video games.

"As Martin Luther King Jr. once said, 'If you can't fly, run. If you can't run, walk. If you can't walk, crawl. But by all means, keep moving."

Researchers used data from one of the world's largest cohorts, tracking kids from 1990.

It was the first study to investigate sedentary time's cumulative effect on the heart. The test group included 766 children, 55 percent of whom were girls.

The findings were presented at the European Society of Cardiology (ESC) congress in Amsterdam,

Inn Traces Roots to 1848

Johnsonville Inn has a rich and robust history dating back to 1848 when Jacob and Diana Stier bought the land from George and Elizabeth Beck. While the land was eventually sold to their son, Phillip in 1863, it was not until 1874 that Phillip's brother, William Gould Stier would build The Constitution House on the property.

In 1889, the Constitution House was sold to Lewis Franklin Reimer who then renamed it the Johnsonville House. After the passing of Reimer in 1939, his grandson Ockey took over the Inn in 1941.

In 1976, the property was purchased and renamed the Red Geranium Country Inn until 1980 when Dan and Ethel Paolini took over the Inn. Danet's Red Geranium Country Inn was a local staple until Dan's passing in 2008.

The Inn changed ownership a few times between 2012 and 2015 until finally landing in the hands of Ed and Donna Curry in 2019. With renovations to bring it into the future, while looking back fondly to the past, it was renamed Johnsonville Inn in 2023.

The 78th Annual Comunale Family Reunion was held August 13, 2023 at the Roseto Ball Park. Emma Toth, daughter of Rachelle and Tom Toth and granddaughter of Dave and Dawn Comunale of Bangor was this year's awardee. Emma is a 2023 graduate of Bangor High School and will be attending Indiana University this fall majoring in nursing.

The Comunale Scholarship was established to provide college grants to descendants of Antonio and Rosario Comunale who migrated to our country from Salerno Italy in the early 1900's. 
