Huge Tahoe Bear Breaking Into Homes Hank the Tank strikes again

SOUTH LAKE TAHOE, Calif. (AP) — The 500-pound black bear has damaged more than 30 properties around Lake Tahoe, and last week broke into yet another home in an endless quest for a quick meal.


Known by residents as Hank the Tank, the giant bear has eluded capture for more than seven months, according to Peter Tira, a spokesman for the California Department of Fish and Wildlife.

"What's problematic about this bear is how large it is," Tira told SF Gate on Sunday. "It's learned to use that size and strength to break into a number of occupied residences, bursting through the garage door or front door. It's pretty frightening."

The bear is responsible for more than 150 incident reports in the region straddling Northern California and Nevada. A Friday break-in at a residence in the Tahoe Keys neighborhood is the latest, according to CBS Sacramento.





National Margarita Day

National Margarita Day on February 22nd rims a glass with salt and serves up a beverage that tastes like the summer sun. Whether you enjoy them on the rocks or blended, this day is for you!


Known to be the most common tequila-based cocktail served in the United States, the margarita is a cocktail that consists of tequila, triple sec, and lime or lemon juice. A key ingredient is the freshly squeezed lime juice. In the United States, the most common lime is the thick-skinned Persian lime. When margaritas are made with lemons, they have a much softer taste.

When it comes to sorting out the legends associated with the origin of the margarita, there are many. Two things are certain; the cocktail included

tequila, and the bartender edged the rim of the glass with salt. In Mexico, when drinking straight tequila (especially if the quality was bad), the best course of action was to down it in one swallow, suck on a wedge of lime, and lick a dash of salt off the back of your hand.

It makes sense that the salt followed the lime and the tequila to the margarita glass.

U.S. Hockey Team "Miracle On Ice"



In one of the most dramatic upsets in Olympic history, the underdog U.S. hockey team, made up of college players, defeats the four-time defending gold-medal winning Soviet team at the XIII Olympic Winter Games in Lake Placid, New York. The Soviet squad, previously regarded as the finest in the world, fell to the youthful American team 4-3 before a frenzied crowd of 10,000 spectators. Two days later, the Americans defeated Finland 4-2 to clinch the hockey gold.

The Soviet team had captured the previous four Olympic hockey golds, going back to 1964, and had not lost an Olympic hockey game since 1968. Three days before the

Lake Placid Games began, the Soviets routed the U.S. team 10-3 in an exhibition game at Madison Square Garden in New York City. The Americans looked scrappy, but few blamed them for it—their average age, after all, was only 22, and their team captain, Mike Eruzione, was recruited from the obscurity of the Toledo Blades of the International League.



What's the Spanish word for January? And the answer: Enero.

In Spanish, the first few months of the year are enero, febrero, and marzo.

Like the English calendar, the months of the year in Spanish are based on the Julian calendar, dating back to Ancient Rome. When Julius Caesar took into account the four seasons of the year (as well as the 365 or so days it takes to round the sun), he adjusted the ten month calendar to include two extra months and a leap day. As a result, the Spanish calendar finds its names from Latin origins:

January: Enero, from the Old Spanish word jenero, which has roots in the Latin januarius. This month honors Janus, the two-faced God that looked upon the past and the future.

Think Spring! Trout Stocking Schedules Available

The Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission (PFBC) announced this week its 2022 trout stocking schedules are now available online (https://www.fishandboat.com/Fish/Stocking/Pages/default.aspx) and on the FishBoatPA mobile app.

The PFBC will stock approximately 3.2 million adult trout in 696 streams and 128 lakes open to public angling. This includes approximately 2.2 million Rainbow Trout, 686,000 Brown Trout and 293,000 Brook Trout. As with past practice, the average size of the trout produced for stocking is 11 inches in length with an average weight of 0.58 pounds.

Volunteers will once again be welcome to participate in stocking activities. Stocking is set to begin the week of Feb. 21 in advance of the statewide Mentored Youth Trout Day on Saturday, March 26, and the statewide opening day of trout season on Saturday, April 2.

The 2022 adult trout stocking schedule is searchable by county, lists the waterways in alphabetical order, and indicates stocking dates and the species of trout that will be stocked.
