Bangor Going to Semi Finals With 48-41 Win Slater Bench Preserves Win

There couldn't be a better example of resilience than that of the Bangor Girls Basketball team's 48 -41 win over Selinsgrove in a District XI AAAAA quarter final game played at Pleasant Valley Saturday afternoon.

The Slaters entered the game with Madaline Stout and Analise Mendez, two of their top players, on the bench with injuries, meaning that when someone needed a rest, Bangor Head coach Ed Zeigenfuss would have fewer options than usual.

Someone needed to step up, and they did.

Sophomore guard Kyleena Gonzalez came off the bench to hit two, big three-pointers in the second half, and sophomore Julia Pinter gave the inside girls a huge lift pulling down rebounds, playing tough defense and hustling for loose balls.

At the outset, Bangor's full-court pressure failed to intimidate the Seals as they connected on a pair of threes to take a 10-4 lead. The Slaters fought back to within a point by quarter's end on a three-pointer by Avery Nelson. With a bit of momentum on their side, the Slaters surged to a 16-12 lead in the second quarter and took a 23-17 lead at halftime.

McKormick Karner, Kaylee Holland, Emma Toth and Nelson contributed to the Slaters' attack as Bangor jumped out to a 32-22 lead with 3:45 to play in the third period. The Seals, however, fought back closing the gap to three, but Gonzalez and Pinter made their presence known helping the Slaters stay in command.

Pinter was also there when senior Emily Ohland rolled an ankle late in the game and went to the bench for a brief respite.

Bangor advanced to the semi final game versus Shikellamy 7:00 p.m. Wednesday March 2 at Shamokin High School. The winner of that game will play the winner of Blue Mountain versus Bethlehem Catholic Saturday March 5 for the championship.

If any Bangor Basketball trivia buff made a connection between Bangor Basketball and Selinsgrove, they're right. In March 1988, the Slater boys defeated the Seals 69-66 in a state playoff game at Liberty. Incidentally, Kaylee Holland's father, Bron, played in that 1988 game. [PHOTO GALLERY](#)

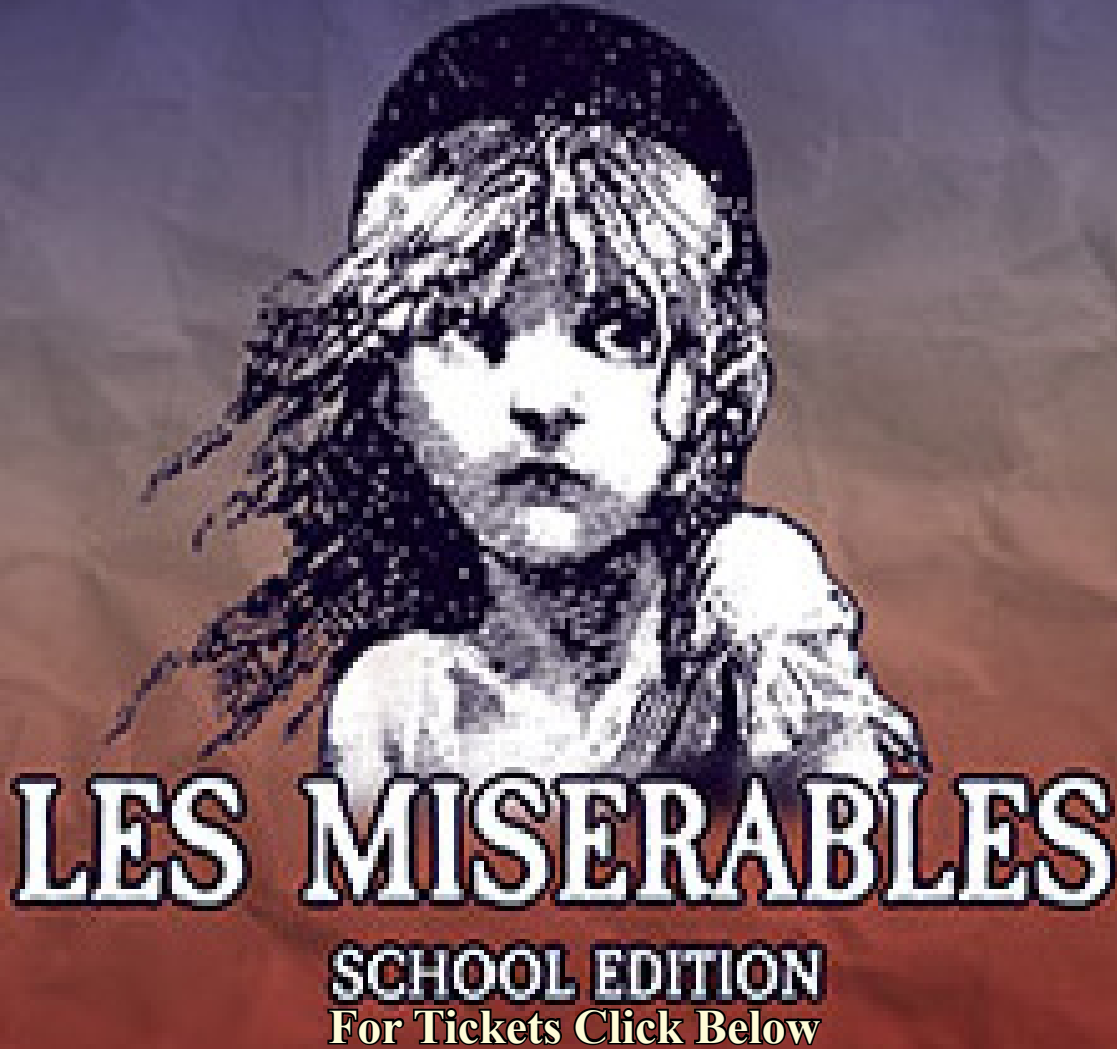

National Polar Bear Day

Polar bears can reach a height of 9 ft tall and a weight of 1400 pounds. They use their large, slightly webbed front paws to paddle as they swim. As they are powerful swimmers, some polar bears swim hundreds of miles from land. However, some of the distance may have been covered by floating on sheets of ice.

Polar bears have a warming layer of fat covered by their thick coat of insulating fur, which helps them live in colder environments.

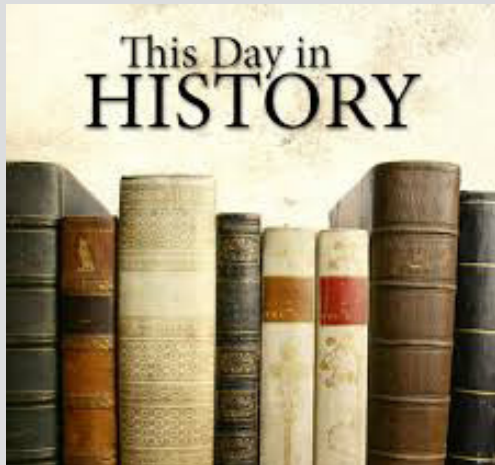
Following English and Mandarin Chinese, which language is the third most spoken native language in the world?

And the answer: Spanish.

Among native speakers, Spanish is one of the most spoken languages in the world. It's the first language for more than 460 million people in Spain, North America, and South America.

Language is constantly spreading, adapting and changing all around us. Even some of the world's most widely spoken languages, like English, Spanish and Mandarin Chinese develop new word uses and associations nearly every day. The English language, for one, is notoriously complex, yet its vocabulary continues to grow exponentially every year. Many new words come from the fields of technology and science.

Chemical Structure Of Dna Discovered



On February 28, 1953, Cambridge University scientists James D. Watson and Francis H.C. Crick announce that they have determined the double-helix structure of DNA, the molecule containing human genes. The molecular biologists were aided significantly by the work of another DNA researcher, Rosalind Franklin, although she is not included in the announcement, nor did she share the subsequent Nobel Prize award for it.

Though DNA—short for deoxyribonucleic acid—was discovered in 1869, its crucial role in determining genetic inheritance wasn't demonstrated until 1943. In the early 1950s, Watson and Crick were only two of many scientists working on figuring out the structure of DNA. California chemist Linus Pauling suggested an incorrect

model at the beginning of 1953, prompting Watson and Crick to try and beat Pauling at his own game.

On the morning of February 28, they determined that the structure of DNA was a double-helix polymer, or a spiral of two DNA strands, each containing a long chain of monomer nucleotides, wound around each other. According to their findings, DNA replicated itself by separating into individual strands.

Think Spring! Trout Stocking Schedules Available

The Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission (PFBC) announced this week its 2022 trout stocking schedules are now available online (<https://www.fishandboat.com/Fish/Stocking/Pages/default.aspx>) and on the FishBoatPA mobile app.
The PFBC will stock approximately 3.2 million adult trout in 696 streams and 128 lakes open to public angling. This includes approximately 2.2 million Rainbow Trout, 686,000 Brown Trout and 293,000 Brook Trout. As with past practice, the average size of the trout produced for stocking is 11 inches in length with an average weight of 0.58 pounds.
Volunteers will once again be welcome to participate in stocking activities. Stocking is set to begin the week of Feb. 21 in advance of the statewide Mentored Youth Trout Day on Saturday, March 26, and the statewide opening day of trout season on Saturday, April 2.
The 2022 adult trout stocking schedule is searchable by county, lists the waterways in alphabetical order, and indicates stocking dates and the species of trout that will be stocked.
