

FASTNACHT DAY

Fastnacht Day or in Pennsylvania German: Faasenacht) is an annual Pennsylvania Dutch celebration that falls on Shrove Tuesday, the day before Ash Wednesday. The word translates to "Fasting Night" or "Almost Night" in English. The tradition is to eat the very best foods, which are part of the German tradition, and much of them, before the Lenten fast. Fastnachts (pronounced /ˈfastnaxt/ in German) are doughnuts.

aka FAT TUESDAY

Festive day celebrated in France on Shrove Tuesday ALSO KNOWN AS Mardi Gras, (French: Fat Tuesday) (the Tuesday before Ash Wednesday), which marks the close of the pre-Lenten season. Fat Tuesday is the custom of using all the fats in the home before Lent in preparation for fasting and abstinence.

aka SHROVE TUESDAY

The Tuesday before Ash Wednesday, which marks the close of the pre-Lenten season. aka Pancake Tuesday is the day before Ash Wednesday, observed in many Christian countries through participating in confession and absolution, the ritual burning of the previous year's Holy Week palms, finalizing one's Lenten sacrifice, as well as eating pancakes and other sweets



February 23 Slavery in Bethlehem

The Rediscovered 1780 Register of Northampton County's Enslaved Persons February 23, 2023, 5:00 pm, John R. Austen Auditorium at Sigal Museum

During the American Revolution, local officials in Pennsylvania were required to compile a list of every enslaved man and woman in each county. Northampton County's "slave register" was thought to be lost—but it was rediscovered in June 2022! This register reveals surprising new information about enslaved men and women in Moravian Bethlehem and in its satellite communities.

Lincoln and Washington's Birthday Morphed Into Presidents Day

Birthday Observance History

1876 - U.S. House of Reps proposed that April 14 (Lincoln) Assassination Date) would be a national holiday for Lincoln.

1900 - Post Offices closed in the afternoon.

1907 - All Northampton County Schools observed Lincoln's Birthday.

1909 - at the Music Hall in Bangor (next to the present Bangor PD office) Union Defenders Day and Lincoln's Birthday were observed by the Sons of Veterans of the Civil War.

1909 - The Shakespearian Literary Society in Pen Argyl observed Lincoln's Birthday.

1914 - Lehigh New England Railroad Shops closed.

1923 - Pen Argyl Schools observed Lincoln's birthday as a holiday.

1924 - Lincoln and Washington's Birthdays were observed in all Bangor Schools.

1924 - PAHS Class of 1924 held a Lincoln Birthday Party.

1936 - Bethlehem Schools Closed.

1939 - Merchants bank of Bangor's move to Broadway delayed by observance of Lincoln's Birthday.

1947 - Banks and Municipal offices closed but schools and post offices were open on Lincoln's Birthday.

Presidents Day History

By the end of WWII, the observance of Lincoln and Washington's birthdays waned except as magnets for special February sales.

Today their birthdays are included in Presidents' Day, which is a holiday in the United States celebrated on the third Monday of February to honor all people who served as presidents of the United States and, since 1879, has been the federal holiday honoring George Washington, who led the Continental Army to victory in the American Revolutionary War, presided at the Constitutional Convention of 1787, and was the first U.S. president.

Washington's Birthday was celebrated on February 22 from 1879 until 1970. To give federal employees a three-day weekend, in 1968 the Uniform Monday Holiday Act moved it to the third Monday in February, which can occur from February 15 to the 21st.

Lincoln's Birthday, February 12, was never a federal holiday, but nearly half the state governments have officially renamed their observances "Presidents' Day", "Washington and Lincoln Day", or other such designations. (In historical rankings of presidents of the United States, Lincoln and Washington are often the top two.







"They don't need fancy. They just need to come in and they know that everyone here is on their side," Person stressed.




