





Continental Congress Ratifies Treaty Of Paris



On January 14, 1784, the Continental Congress ratifies the Treaty of Paris, ending the War for Independence.

In the document, which was known as the Second Treaty of Paris because the Treaty of Paris was also the name of the agreement that had ended the Seven Years' War in 1763, Britain officially agreed to recognize the independence of its 13 former colonies as the new United States of America.

In addition, the treaty settled the boundaries between the United States and what remained of British North America. U.S. fishermen won the right to fish in the Grand Banks, off the Newfoundland coast, and in the Gulf of Saint Lawrence. Both sides agreed to ensure payment to creditors in the other nation of debts incurred during the

war and to release all prisoners of war. The United States promised to return land confiscated during the war to its British owners, to stop any further confiscation of British property and to honor the property left by the British army on U.S. shores, including Negroes or slaves. Both countries assumed perpetual rights to access the Mississippi River.



In 1972, Richard Nixon and Spiro Agnew won the Republican ticket for President and Vice President. The next year, Agnew resigned due to scandal, and Nixon appointed Gerald Ford as VP. The following year, Nixon resigned due to the Watergate scandal, and Ford became President. Ford is known as the President who wasn't meant to be. After growing up in Grand Rapids, Michigan, and graduating from Yale Law School, Ford served in the U.S. Navy in World War II before earning a seat in the U.S. Congress. During his 25 years in Congress, Ford rose through the ranks to become the Republican House Minority Leader.


