Slippery roads in Slate Belt from Snow & Rain

A winter storm left two inches of slush in Pen Argyl this morning resulting from overnight snow and .34 inches of rain. Temperatures remained below freezing until 4:00am this morning.

Rain, however, began falling at 2:30 a.m. resulting in a freezing layer which has begun to melt as the temperature has continued to rise to 34 at 8:00 a.m.

Some rain and snow is expected until 1:00 p.m. today. The NWS forecast predicts gusty winds approaching 30 mph this afternoon. Be alert for slippery conditions tonight when the temperature drops below freezing.

Martin Luther King Jr. Day

On the third Monday in January, Martin Luther King Jr Day honors the American clergyman, activist, Civil Rights Movement leader. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.(January 15, 1929 – April 4, 1968) is best known for his role in advancing civil rights using nonviolent civil disobedience. King has become a national icon in the history of American progressivism.

A gifted and friendly student, King attended Morehouse College, earning a B.A. in sociology. Combining a passion for racial equality with a rediscovered spirituality, King then attended Crozer Theological Seminary, following in his father’s and grandfather’s footsteps earning a Bachelors of Divinity.

Shortly after completing his Ph.D. in theology at Boston University in 1955, a 42-year-old Rosa Parks (See Rosa Parks Day observed December 1st) refused to give up her seat on a bus in Montgomery, Alabama. The opportunity for the NAACP to bring their civil rights efforts to the forefront was before them, and they chose King to lead the successful city-wide boycott of the Montgomery transit system.



QUESTION OF THE DAY

What’s the scientific word for your kneecap?

And the answer: **patella.**

In short, your patella is your kneecap. It’s a small bone located in front of your knee joint, where the thighbone and shinbone meet. Your patella protects your knee, and connects the muscles in the front of your thigh to your shin.

This small but fascinating bone is essential to everyday function. While some animals are born without it (sorry, ostriches), it helps humans protect the vital muscles and ligaments that meet in your knee. The patella also increases the leverage of the knee’s straightening muscles, so not as much force is needed to straighten the knee.

While the patella is a reasonably small bone in your body, it is the largest sesamoid bone we have, which means it is embedded within a tendon.

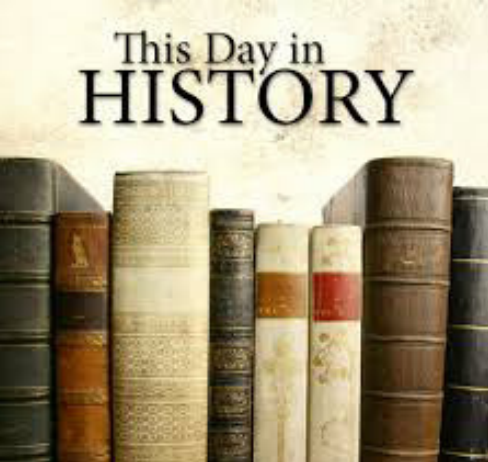

Boston Thieves Pull Off Historic Brink’s Robbery



On January 17, 1950, 11 men steal more than \$2 million (\$29 million today) from the Brink’s Armored Car depot in Boston, Massachusetts. It was the perfect crime—almost—as the culprits weren’t caught until January 1956, just days before the statute of limitations for the theft expired.

The robbery’s mastermind was Anthony “Fats” Pino, a career criminal who recruited a group of 10 other men to stake out the depot for 18 months to figure out when it held the most money. Pino’s men then managed to steal plans for the depot’s alarm system, returning them before anyone noticed they were gone.

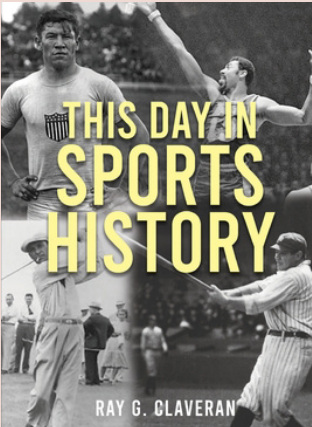
Wearing navy blue coats and chauffeur’s caps—similar to the Brink’s employee uniforms—with rubber Halloween masks, the thieves entered the depot with copied keys, surprising and tying up several employees inside the company’s counting room. Filling 14 canvas bags with cash, coins, checks and money orders—for a total weight of more than half a ton—the men were out and in their getaway car in about 30 minutes. Their haul? More than \$2.7 million—the largest robbery in U.S. history up until that time.

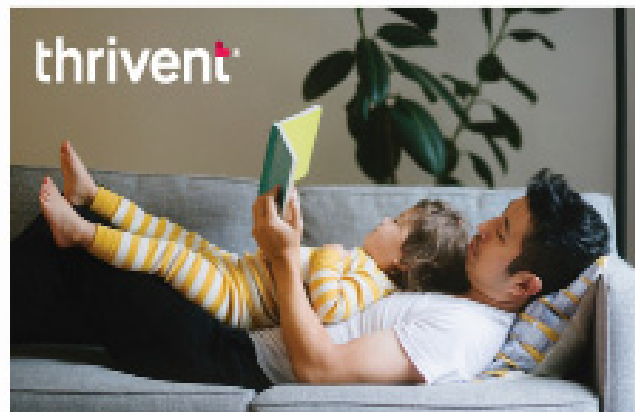

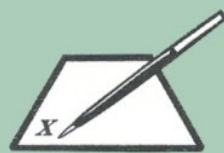

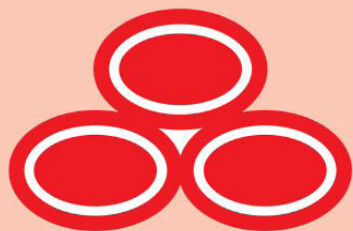

Appointments Required for Vaccines at LVHN
