## BASD Kindergarten - Welcome Class of 2035

The Bangor Area School District (BASD) is excited to welcome the Class of 2035. The kindergarten team at Five Points Elementary School is looking forward to working with the new kindergarten class for the 2022-2023 School Year. A child is eligible for kindergarten if he/she is at least the age of five (5) years by August 29, 2022, resides within the boundaries of BASD, and successfully completes the district's kindergarten screening process.

Kindergarten registration is online. Online kindergarten registration is available for parents and/or guardians through the district website ([www.bangorslaters.com](http://www.bangorslaters.com)). Once packets are received and confirmed complete, BASD will contact parents/guardians to schedule a kindergarten screening appointment in June of 2022. Completed packets must be received no later than May 1st to guarantee a screening appointment in June.

- A completed registration includes:
- Parent/Guardian Photo Identification
- Proof of child's birth date (must be at least five (5) years by August 29, 2022)
- Two (2) proofs of residency
- Immunization
- Physical Exam Record
- Dental Exam Record

To schedule a screening appointment, the completed online registration and mandatory documents must be submitted and approved by the registration secretary. Kindergarten screenings for the 2022-2023 school year will occur between in June of 2022.

All screenings are by appointment only. An adult must accompany the child(ren) for their screening appointment(s). A parent/guardian registration information meeting is scheduled on Tuesday, January 25, 2022, at 7:00 p.m. in Five Points Elementary School.

# National Winnie the Pooh Day

National Winnie the Pooh Day on January 18th commemorates author A.A. Milne's birthday in 1882. He brought the adorable, honey-loving bear to life in his stories, which also featured his son, Christopher Robin.

Milne's lovable Pooh Bear, as he was fondly called, is a fictional bear inspired by a black bear named Winnie. Winnie lived at the London Zoo during World War I. The author's son, Christopher Robin, would visit the bear often and named his own teddy bear after her and a swan named Pooh.

his friendship inspired a collection of books starting with When We Were Young in 1924. E.H. Shepard beautifully illustrated the books.

Their adventures took them and millions of children through the Hundred Acre Woods. Each character played a unique role in the books. Whether the wisdom of Owl or Rabbit lead the group awry or a celebration ensued, the story's characters became beloved around the world.

In the 1960s, Disney bought the rights to the Winnie-the-Pooh characters dropping the hyphen from Pooh's name.

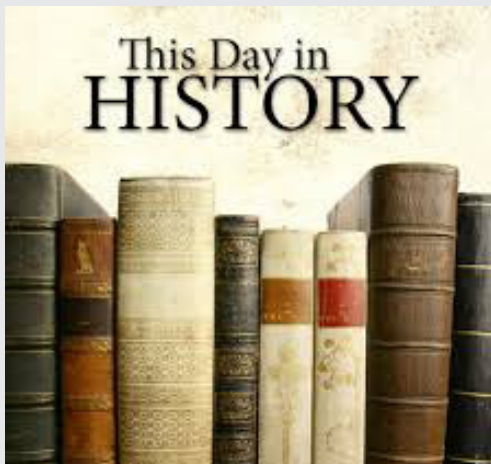
Which Broadway musical was inspired by a book by T. S. Eliot?

Published in 1939, Old Possum's Book of Practical Cats is a collection of whimsical poems by T.S. Eliot. Several of the poems inspired Andrew Lloyd Webber's 1981 musical Cats, including "The Song of the Jellicles," "Mr. Mistoffelees," and "Old Deuteronomy."

What began as silly poems soon grew into a worldwide phenomenon that continues to mesmerize audiences today. Cats the musical comes in just behind The Lion King as the fourth-longest running show on Broadway, and has been adapted to the screen as recently as 2019.

## Post-World War I Peace Conference Begins In Paris



On January 18, 1919, in Paris, France, some of the most powerful people in the world meet to begin the long, complicated negotiations that would officially mark the end of the First World War.

Leaders of the victorious Allied powers—France, Great Britain, the United States and Italy—would make most of the crucial decisions in Paris over the next six months. For most of the conference, U.S. President Woodrow Wilson struggled to support his idea of a "peace without victory" and make sure that Germany, the leader of the Central Powers and the major loser of the war, was not treated too harshly. On the other hand, Prime Ministers Georges Clemenceau of France and David Lloyd George of Britain argued that punishing Germany adequately and ensuring its weakness was the only way to

justify the immense costs of the war. In the end, Wilson compromised on the treatment of Germany in order to push through the creation of his pet project, an international peacekeeping organization called the League of Nations. Representatives from Germany were excluded from the peace conference until May, when they arrived in Paris and were presented with a draft of the Versailles Treaty.
