Eagle Scout Jack Scherer Completes Conservation Project in Bushkill Twp

Jack Scherer from Troop 34 Pen Argyl recently completed his Eagle Scout Project at Albert Ponds in Bushkill Township.

Located on Albert Road between Old Sullivan Trail and Route 33, Albert Ponds property sits on 60 acres and includes two large ponds for fishing.

In addition to the benches, bat boxes and blue bird houses, Jack also installed a historical board honoring the pond's history.

Karen Hendershot, wife of Rob Hendershot, was very pleased with the historical pictures which show the pond's development.

This is one of the last 15 carousels made by CW Parker of Leavenworth, Kansas. This carousel horses and mechanics are all original and authentic. It features 20 metal horses that have been restored and painted in 1992. There are 2 rows of horses, which are all William Mangels jumpers, which move front to back in a galloping motion. This carousel also includes 2 carriages. Rounding board is artwork by Charles Walker (The late Charles Walker was a renowned carousel historian based in the US.) It has the original mechanics and sweeps. The carousel was previously owned by a prominent pediatric orthodontic dentist near Atlanta. He had this carousel on display (housed in a separate building) next to his dental office and operated it 4 to 5 times annually for patient parties and charity events.





Fleetwood Mac Plays 'Don't Stop' Clinton's Inaugural



On January 19, 1993, the band Fleetwood Mac reunites to perform at the recently elected U.S. President Bill Clinton's first inaugural gala.

Fleetwood Mac had faced much intra-band squabbling since their 1970s heyday, why they released one of the biggest albums of all time—Rumours—and a string of decade-defining hits like "Landslide," "Rhiannon," "Say You Love Me" and "Go Your Own Way." And then, of course, there was "Don't Stop" (as in "thinking about tomorrow"), which was candidate Bill Clinton's unofficial theme song during the 1992 presidential campaign.

Along with Truman's "I'm Just Wild About Harry," Eisenhower's "I Like Ike" and Ross Perot's "Crazy," Clinton's "Don't Stop" can

certainly be placed within the catchy-and-memorable subset of Presidential campaign songs—in contrast to, say, "Buckle Down with Nixon," "Get on a Raft with Taft" and "Huzzah for Madison." 




