Bangor Students Selected for District 10 Band

Bangor High School band director Mr. Kevin Horne has announced that four students have been selected to be members of the Pennsylvania Music Educators Association District 10 Band.

They are CJ Fassl on Horn, Evan Finkbeiner on Euphonium, Nikita Mendelsohn on Clarinet, and Connor Condel on Snare Drum/Battery Percussion. In addition, selected for PMEA District 10 Orchestra were CJ Fassl on Horn and Connor Condel on Orchestral Percussion.

They were among hundreds of students who auditioned from schools in the counties of Berks, Carbon, Lehigh, Monroe, Northampton, Pike, and Schuylkill. Of those, 129 were selected to create the District 10 Band and 112 were selected to create the District 10 Orchestra. The District 10 Band Festival will be held January 28-29 at Easton Middle School and the District 10 Orchestra Festival will be held January 14-15 at Catasauqua High School.

National Spaghetti Day

National Spaghetti Day on January 4th offers an opportunity to pick your sauce and add it to that long, thin cylindrical pasta of Italian and Sicilian origin. Usually made from semolina flour, this pasta has been a worldwide favorite for ages and loved by millions.

There are various pasta dishes based on spaghetti, and the sauce determines most of them. Some examples include spaghetti ala Carbonara, garlic and oil, tomato sauce, meat sauce, bolognese, Alfredo sauce, clam sauce, or other sauces. In addition, we traditionally serve spaghetti dishes topped with grated hard cheeses such as Pecorino Romano, Parmesan, and Grana Padano.

The word spaghetti is plural for the Italian word spaghetti, which is a diminutive of spago, meaning “thin string” or “twine.”

American restaurants offered spaghetti around the end of the 19th century as Spaghetti Italiane (which is believed to have consisted of noodles cooked past al dente and a mild tomato sauce flavored with easily found spices and vegetables such as cloves, bay leaves, and garlic).



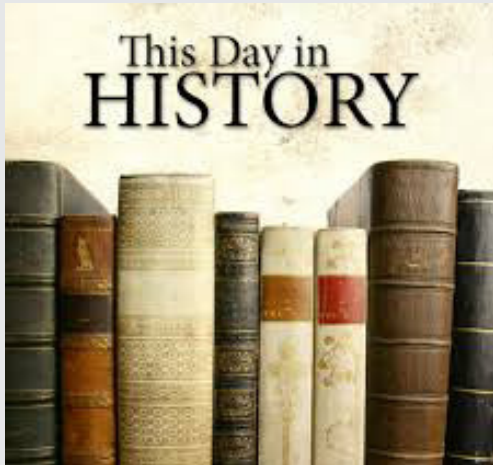

Written in the 1600s by the Miguel de Cervantes, Don Quixote is considered the first modern novel, as well as the most translated novel of all time. Throughout the story, Sancho Panza makes observations to his friend that are a combination of ironic Spanish proverbs, broad humor, and pragmatic wit. Sancho Panza serves as a foil to the idealism of his master, Don Quixote. Many famous proverbs come from Panza’s character, as Cervantes used the disconnect between idealism and realism to explore its complex intersections. Cervantes used the two characters to ultimately attempt to symbolize the duality of man,.

LBJ Envisions Great Society In State of Union Talk



On January 4, 1965, in his State of the Union address, President Lyndon Baines Johnson lays out for Congress a laundry list of legislation needed to achieve his plan for a Great Society. On the heels of John F. Kennedy’s tragic death, Americans had elected Johnson, his vice president, to the presidency by the largest popular vote in the nation’s history. Johnson used this mandate to push for improvements he believed would better Americans’ quality of life.

Following Johnson’s lead, Congress enacted sweeping legislation in the areas of civil rights, health care, education and the environment. The 1965 State of the Union address heralded the creation of Medicare/Medicaid, Head Start, the Voting Rights Act, the Civil Rights Act, the Department of Housing and Urban Development

and the White House Conference on Natural Beauty. Johnson also signed the National Foundation of the Arts and Humanities Act, out of which emerged the National Endowment for the Arts and the National Endowment for the Humanities. Through the Economic Opportunity Act, Johnson fought a War on Poverty by implementing improvements in early childhood education and fair employment.
