

Winter Weather Advisory for the Slate Belt Freezing Rain Possible 7am - 1pm Sunday

A Winter Weather Advisory is in effect from 5 am to 1 pm Sunday for freezing rain with total ice accumulations of up to one-tenth of an inch in New Jersey, Sussex and Warren and in Pennsylvania, Berks, Lehigh and Northampton.

Very slippery sidewalks, roads and bridges are possible. The hazardous conditions could impact the morning commute. Slow down and use caution while traveling.

Coldest Weather Since 2019 follows Icing

Sunday's Ice Storm will be followed by the coldest weather since January 30, 2019. The low temperature last night registered 14 at the Town Topics weather station in Pen Argyl which is the coldest weather in four years since the mercury bottomed out at minus 4 degrees in 2019. Fortunately, sub-zero temperatures for this area are not very common.

Last night's low of 14, however, is relatively warm compared to the 6-degree low forecasted for this Tuesday night January 11.

The good news is that our current cold spell should be short lived. According to the NWS seven-day outlook, the temperature is expected to rise to a relatively mild temperature of 39 degrees by next Friday. The current seven-day is also free of any storms.

However, NWS does indicate a slight chance for precipitation next Thursday according to their daily forecast discussion this morning : "Can't rule out some light precipitation by this time as a couple of shortwaves track nearby, but they look quite moisture starved at the moment with little fanfare expected."

The bubbles on top of the water (also known as foam bath or foaming bath) insulate the bathwater, keeping it warmer for a more extended period.


Children find bubble baths fun and enjoy playing with the bubbles, which entice them to take their baths.

Crazy Horse Fights Last Battle



On January 8, 1877, Oglala Lakota warrior Crazy Horse and his men-outnumbered, low on ammunition and forced to use outdated weapons to defend themselves-fight their final losing battle against the U.S. Cavalry in Montana.

Six months earlier, in the Battle of the Little Bighorn, Crazy Horse and his ally, Sitting Bull, led their combined forces of Sioux and Cheyenne to a stunning victory over Lieutenant Colonel George Custer (1839-76) and his men. The Native Americans were resisting the U.S. government's efforts to force them back to their reservations. After Custer and over 200 of his soldiers were killed in the conflict, later dubbed "Custer's Last Stand," the white American public wanted revenge. As a result, the U.S. Army launched a winter

campaign in 1876-77, led by General Nelson Miles (1839-1925), against the remaining tribes on the Northern Plains.

Combining military force with diplomatic overtures, Nelson convinced many Native Americans to surrender and return to their reservations. Much to Nelson's frustration, though, Sitting Bull refused to give in and fled.


