## Could Exercise Be The Answer To Good Sleeping?

Research Team Hopes Findings Influence The Sleep Advice



Exercise could be the answer to a better night sleep, as people who work out more are less likely to need sleeping pills, a new study reveals.

But the beneficial effect of exercise is stronger for men than for

New research shows that 10 to 20 percent of the population suffer from serious long-term sleep problems, leading many to resort to some form of sleeping aid to get by.

However, researchers believe that exercising could be a better solution.

Dr. Linda Ernstsen, an associate professor at the Norwegian University of Science and Technology, said: "We've observed that people who are in better physical condition have a lower risk of taking prescription sleeping pills."

The findings show that the fittest men had a 15 percent lower risk of needing drugs to help them sleep, while women who exercised regularly were only five per cent less likely to need sleeping drugs.

Ernstsen said: "The corresponding percentage risk for the fittest women was much lower. But women who struggle with sleep can still benefit from getting in better shape."

The team reviewed data from Norway's large Trøndelag Health Survey.

A total of 240,000 people from Trondheim, Norway, have taken part in the survey since it began in 1984.

The participants, who had an average age of just over 51, were all observed until January 1, 2018.

The survey allowed researchers to follow the evolution of people's health over many years.

They found that around 17 percent of the participants' sleep issues were serious enough to warrant a prescription from their doctor.

Ernstsen said: "Almost 5,800 of the participants received their first prescription sleep medication during the study period."

However, the fitter participants used fewer of these prescription drugs.

The research team hopes these findings influence the sleep advice that doctors give their patients.


Ernstsen added: "Our findings support the idea that improving or maintaining fitness can be an effective alternative for preventing sleep problems."

The results of the study were published by Mayo Clinic Proceedings.



## Roseto Ice Rink Becomes a Reality

For several years Roseto Councilman Ken Tillman attempted to provide an ice skating venue at Roseto Ballpark. Each winter he and workers from the borough created a section of ice at the park for ice skating and hockey. Problem was - the ice didn't last - it melted.

After several years Tillman and the borough decided to use artificial ice, but not the kind that would be used in an arena with refrigerated pipes. Roseto, however, is using interlocking plastic sections to form a rink that covers the basketball court at the ballpark which is open to the public everyday from 8-8.

The cost of the project was funded by a generous donation from the estate of the late Dr. Albert Falcone.

According to google, the first known instance of plastic

products as a substitute for real or artificial ice for the purpose of skating was back in the 1960s.

Basically, the main difference between real ice, artificial or natural, and synthetic ice is glide. When you skate on ice, the heat from the friction of your blade causes the ice to melt slightly.

The small amount of water this friction produces allows you to slide or glide over the ice. This water acts as a lubricant against drag. With synthetic ice, this lubrication had to be fabricated.

However, with newer products that is no longer the case. A slip agent is built into the polymer sheets which the manufacturer says will never leak.
