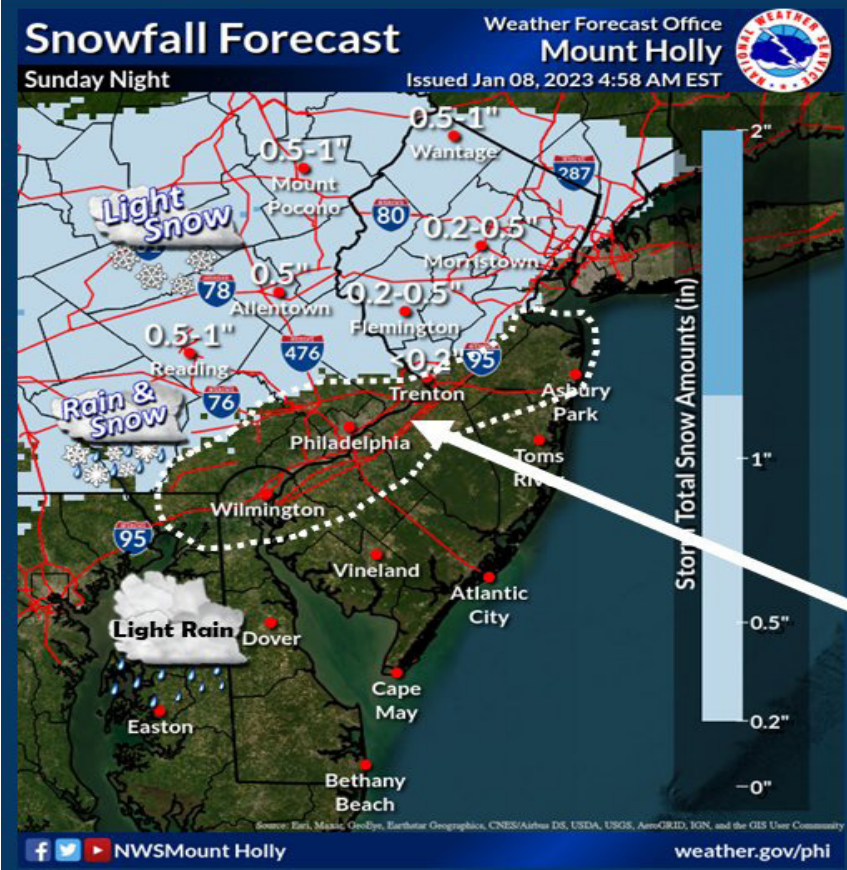

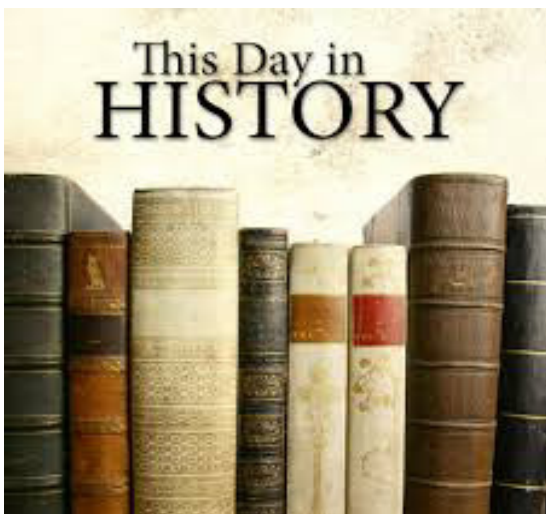

This Day In History

Crazy Horse Fights Last Battle

On January 8, 1877, Oglala Lakota warrior Crazy Horse and his men—outnumbered, low on ammunition and forced to use outdated weapons to defend themselves—fight their final losing battle against the U.S. Cavalry in Montana.



Six months earlier, in the Battle of the Little Bighorn, Crazy Horse and his ally, Sitting Bull, led their combined forces of Sioux and Cheyenne to a stunning victory over Lieutenant Colonel George Custer (1839-76) and his men. The Native Americans were resisting the U.S. government's efforts to force them back to their reservations. After Custer and over 200 of his soldiers were killed in the conflict, later dubbed "Custer's Last Stand," the white American public wanted revenge. As a result, the U.S. Army launched a winter campaign in 1876-77, led by General Nelson Miles (1839-1925), against the remaining tribes on the Northern Plains.

Average American Woman Will Pop More Than 4,000 Pimples In a Lifetime

The average American woman pops a total of 65 pimples annually.

That's 4,153 popped zits in the average U.S. woman's adult lifetime.

A new study of 2,000 American women uncovered the not-so-dermatologist-recommended ways respondents have taken revitalizing their skin into their own hands – in some cases, quite literally.

Over eight in ten American women admit to popping pimples.

Yet 58% of respondents who have done this haven't learned their lesson, with this percentage saying they have at least one scar from their forays into pimple popping territory.

One reason? Over three-quarters of those who pop say they know it's bad for their pores, but the urge to pop is just too strong.

Conducted by OnePoll on behalf of Truly Beauty, the survey also examined the most common skincare sins among respondents.

Popping pimples (81%), taking long, hot showers (49%) and not washing your face before bed (43%) are among the most common skincare sins to which respondents admitted.

In addition to their pimple-popping tendencies, more than half of respondents are compulsive face-pickers, with 52% saying they pick at the skin on their face without realizing it.



Roseto Ice Rink Becomes a Reality

For several years Roseto Councilman Ken Tillman attempted to provide an ice skating venue at Roseto Ballpark. Each winter he and workers from the borough created a section of ice at the park for ice skating and hockey. Problem was - the ice didn't last - it melted.

After several years Tillman and the borough decided to use artificial ice, but not the kind that would be used in an arena with refrigerated pipes. Roseto, however, is using interlocking plastic sections to form a rink that covers the basketball court at the ballpark which is open to the public everyday from 8-8.

The cost of the project was funded by a generous donation from the estate of the late Dr. Albert Falcone.

According to google, the first known instance of plastic

products as a substitute for real or artificial ice for the purpose of skating was back in the 1960s.

Basically, the main difference between real ice, artificial or natural, and synthetic ice is glide. When you skate on ice, the heat from the friction of your blade causes the ice to melt slightly.

The small amount of water this friction produces allows you to slide or glide over the ice. This water acts as a lubricant against drag. With synthetic ice, this lubrication had to be fabricated.

However, with newer products that is no longer the case. A slip agent is built into the polymer sheets which the manufacturer says will never leak.
