## Area Spared Severe Storms - Nice Today

Fortunately, the Slate Belt was spared from the severe weather yesterday as close as Hellertown. According to a check of two dozen or so local weather stations, the Slate Belt received .79 inches of rain yesterday which is within a few drops of the area average, but nothing more.

### Future Weather:

**Today**, Sunny, with a high near 78. Northwest wind 10 to 15 mph.

**Tonight**, Mostly clear, with a low around 51. North wind 5 to 10 mph.

**Saturday**, Sunny, with a high near 76. West wind around 5 mph.

**Saturday Night**, Mostly clear, with a low around 56. Calm wind.

**Sunday**, A chance of showers, then showers likely and possibly a thunderstorm after 2pm. Mostly sunny, with a high near 76. Light south wind increasing to 5 to 10 mph in the morning. Chance of precipitation is 60%. New rainfall amounts of less than a tenth of an inch, except higher amounts possible in thunderstorms.

**Sunday Night**, Showers likely and possibly a thunderstorm before 8pm,

**Air Quality: Good** (0-50) Current reading of 54 in Columbia, NJ.

**Pollen today: Medium** 6.4 rating on a scale of 12. Top pollen producers today will be grasses, plaitain, and nettle.

**UV Rays Today: Very High** risk of harm from unprotected sun exposure. Alert in effect for 7 hours between 10-5pm. High 7.5 on a scale of 12 at 1pm.

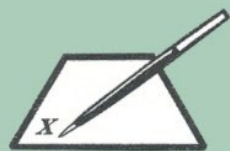

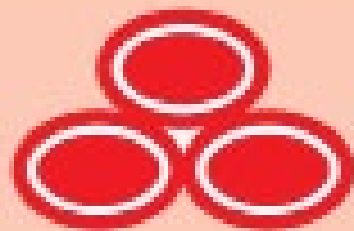
