Severe Impact From Elsa Not Likely in Slate Belt

Flash Flood Watch From Noon Today Thru Friday Morning.

With the Slate Belt still dealing with downed trees and power outages from Tuesday night's thunderstorms, tropical storm Elsa will be bring another round of storms to the Slate Belt beginning later today. Fortunately, the Slate Belt is on the western fringe of the storm. According to information released at 5:00am this morning by the National Hurricane Center, rainfall in the Slate Belt will not likely exceed two inches. Wind is also not expected to pose any problems.

Nonetheless, the National Weather Service says that a Flash Flood Watch continues for portions of northern New Jersey and Pennsylvania, including in northern New Jersey Sussex and Warren and in Pennsylvania the Slate Belt, and Berks, Carbon, Lehigh, Monroe, and Northampton counties from noon today through Friday morning.

Heavy rainfall will develop over portions of eastern Pennsylvania and northwestern New Jersey ahead of Tropical Storm Elsa this afternoon. The area will see 1 to 2 inches of rain with locally higher amounts at that time. Another 1 to 2 inches of rain is expected with Tropical Storm Elsa tonight into early Friday morning.

Heavy rain in a short period of time may cause streams and creeks to rise quickly out of their banks and there is the potential for flash flooding in areas of poor drainage.

Storms Today More Rain Friday

Today, a chance of showers before noon, then a chance of showers and thunderstorms between noon and 1pm, then showers likely and possibly a thunderstorm after 1pm.
