# Flood Watch Noon Today Thru This Evening

Flooding caused by excessive rainfall continues to be possible from noon today through this evening. Excessive runoff may result in flooding of rivers, creeks, streams, and other low-lying and flood-prone locations. Flooding may also occur in poor drainage and urban areas.

A slow moving line of heavy showers and thunderstorms is expected to develop and move east across the watch area this afternoon and evening. Widespread rainfall amounts of 1 to 2 inches are expected with localized amounts of 3 to 5 inches possible. These totals may result in flash flooding of urban and low lying areas.



# **Recreational Vehicle Laws** Enacted in Pen Argyl Please note: Chapter 103. Vehicles and Traffic, Article VI. Parking of

Recreational Vehicles,

§ 103-26. Time limit for parking on public property. States: The parking of a recreational vehicle upon any public property, including public streets, for any period of time in excess of 72 consecutive hours is prohibited. The consecutive hours shall not be considered broken or terminated unless the recreational vehicle shall have been removed from public property, including public streets, for a period of 48 consecutive hours.

#### **Recreational Vehicle is defined as:**

The single-axle or multiple-axle structure mounted on wheels or otherwise capable of being made mobile for the purpose of travel or recreation and shall include, but not be limited to, travel trailers, mobile homes, tent trailers, boat trailers, home trailers and any trailers used to transport snowmobiles.

Please note that due to increased violations, public concern and parking congestion the Slate Belt Regional Police Department will begin to cite these types of vehicles beginning 6/26/2023

# Mt. Carmel Big Time Celebrating 130 Years

he Our Lady of Mount Carmel Church "Big Time" is a time-honored tradition and will be celebrating 130 years of amusement, delightful food, and most importantly family. The tradition of the "Big Time" brings decades of family generations together to reminisce about old times past and to look forward to making new memories in the future.

The 130-year-old "Big Time" is one of the longest running Italian festivals in the United States and is still going strong. This year's event will be held July 26th-30th.

The Annual "Big Time" dates back to 1893. The initial celebration was patterned after the festival that took place in Roseto Valfortore, Italy. The festival days were set aside to honor Mary, the Mother of Jesus. The festival is a five-day event beginning on a Wednesday and ending Sunday afternoon.

The "Big Time" is ever evolving but keeps the traditions intact. Entertainment, although there is no longer a circus, includes amusement rides for all ages and bands that play old school Italian favorites as well as modern hits for all generations.

A vast assortment of food complements the entertainment. This includes long

On a beautiful summer night the streets of Roseto are filled with wonder and on this one night you could call Roseto the tiny city that doesn't sleep.


















# Pen Argyl High School Class of 1973 50th Reunion


