# Sleep Survey Reveals Top Things People's Partners Do To Ruin Their Sleep

#### By Talker Research

Preparing to move in with your partner soon? You may want to make room for their favorite stuffed animal.

According to new data, fifty-two percent of Americans grew up sleeping with a security blanket or stuffed animal, and 77% reported continuing to do so, even when sharing a bed with their partner.

The recent study of 2,000 U.S. adults who live with a partner discovered that, when it comes to being a considerate co-sleeper, some of your current bedtime rituals may need to be re-considered.

Conducted by OnePoll for Serta Simmons Bedding, the survey delved into the sleeping and nighttime habits of cohabiting couples and discovered some of their top sleep disruptors including when their partner steals the covers (35%), wakes them up tossing and turning (35%), sleeps with the television on (28%), snores (28%) or sleeps with the lights on (27%).

Another non-negotiable for many? Showering before bed. Nearly two-thirds (64%) of those polled claimed to always shower before bed, while 58% said they'd be bothered if their partner didn't.

"Co-sleeping comes with its own set of sleep disruptors. For those looking to achieve higher quality sleep when co-sleeping, it's important to work with your partner to agree to a sleep routine and environment which could range from regular sleep and wake times to removing unnecessary distractions from the bedroom," said Laura Brewick, President of Serta, Serta Simmons Bedding. "The right mattress can also help. Individuals who co-sleep should look for sleep products that offer features addressing motion transfer to avoid middle-of-the-night wake-ups as well as cooling technology, which becomes more essential when sharing a bed."


Respondents seem to agree.

When asked what could contribute to better sleep, a new/better mattress (36%), new/better pillows (34%), or a bigger bed (29%) topped the list.

But there is another option co-sleeping couples are considering to get better rest – sleeping apart. Nearly half of those surveyed (49%) are willing to try sleeping in a separate bed, and that may be because the average cohabiting person receives less than four good nights of sleep a week.

# Slate Belt Heritage Center Announces Winners For 2023 Annual Preservation Awards

### **Special Focus Award Hope Horn**

The Special Focus Award goes to an individual who has shown exemplary actions in saving or conserving traditions or a body of knowledge and contributes to educational information. This award is to acknowledge individuals who have performed acts that promote and preserve the culture and heritage of the Slate Belt. This year's winner is Ms. Hope Horn. Ms. Horn was nominated back in February 2020 due to her continuous teachings of the 'Wool School' out of the former Oughoughton one-room schoolhouse in Richmond, PA.

Ms. Horn has spent countless hours in her school teaching classes on dying, spinning and weaving products from wool, while using her own sheep and goats, and doing all the sheering herself along with dying the wool with natural produces like goldenrod. She also sells products at the adjacent restored general store located next to the school. Ms. Horn has a passion for passing on educational information and conserving a traditional body of knowledge. For this, she has been nominated for the Special Focus Award for 2023.

### **Architectural Award Raymond DiFebo**

The Architectural Award goes to an individual who has shown an exemplary act in saving or conserving a historic building, place or artifact where restoration is authentic to preservation. The award is to acknowledge individuals who have performed acts that promote and preserve the culture and heritage of the Slate Belt. This year's winner is Mr. Raymond DiFebo. Mr. DiFebo was also nominated back in February 2020 for his work taking the former pre-1900s Fosbinder Butcher Shop located in Martin's Creek and restoring it as a place of residence. The original store counter now rests in the kitchen. Additionally, the original posts and beams, block and tackle for moving carcasses, meat hooks, wainscoting and tin ceiling have also been retained, along with the storeroom for animal hides and the concrete smokehouse. Mr. DiFebo has preserved a historic building, as well as authentic and original artifacts. For this he has been nominated for the Architectural Award for 2023.

### **Architectural Business Award** Aline Haddad and Jesse Poliskiewicz

Additionally within the Architectural Award, SBHC also recognizes businesses who have shown an exemplary act in saving or conserving a historic building, place or artifact where restoration is authentic to preservation. The award is to acknowledge businesses who have performed acts that promote and preserve the culture and heritage of the Slate Belt. This year's winner is Johnsonville Farm & Garden. Owners, Aline Haddad and Jesse Poliskiewicz operate a community-based general store stocked with agricultural necessities and local products. In general, Ms. Haddad came up with the concept of restoring and reopening the former store when she returned home from college in 2012 after




