# West Bangor War Memorial Dedicated June 15, 1947

Story reprinted from the Morning Call June 16,1947

Rev. James P. Gallagher, pastor of St. Roch's Catholic church, West Bangor, and Rev. F. C. Capozzi, Wind Gap, pastor of St. Joseph's Episcopal Church, West Bangor, delivered (an) address at (the) dedication of the West Bangor War Memorial yesterday afternoon on the Hillside Rod and Gun Club property.

Rev. Gallagher pleaded for the winning of the peace so that the two members on the honor roil who died in World War II, may not have given their lives in vain. Christ died of love, He came for the salvation of souls, he said. "No greater love hath any man than. to lay down his life for his friends. Those who gave their lives in the last war gave it that we might have real peace. We can not have peace with such great hatred as there is in the world today," he added.

"We must instill in our lives the love of God. We can not have hatred in our hearts if we love God," the speaker said. "By instilling this love in our hearts, those who gave their lives will not have died in vain. Rev. Capozzi declared that "there Is room for all to live together in this great world and we can have peace if we learn to live together."

The memorial was unveiled by Mrs. Lena Zegalia and Antonella Carbone, sisters of the two boys on the roll who made the supreme sacrifice in the past war.

Joseph Curcio, chairman of the committee in charge, was master of ceremonies. Taps were blown by Philip Voneili and Granville ' Branton firing squad or the Wind Gap American Legion post, commanded by Jack Williams, fired a salute over the memorial. Rev. Capozzi offered the Invocation and pronounced the benediction.

The memorial contains the names of 82 veterans of World War II, and 17 of World War I. It has two gold stars for Patsy Verona, killed on Leyte, and for Tribio Carbone, killed in England. It also contains the pictures of these two boys. The list of veterans of World War II includes two WACS.

The memorial was sponsored by the Hillside Rod and Gun club and the committee in charge consists of Joseph Curcio, chairman; John Graziano, Nicholas Calli, Nicholas Valetti, George Smith, Pasqual Catino and Joseph Caesar.






