Slater Softball & Baseball Teams Win in Final Inning

Alexandria Carson & Hunter Rydell Drive In Winning Runs

Bangor's Alexandria Carson hit a sacrifice fly in the seventh inning versus NDGP Wednesday driving in the winning run for a 7-6 win and the Slaters' 16th straight win.

Carson also singled up the middle in the fifth inning to culminate a six-run rally and put the Slaters in the lead at 6-4.

Carson's heroics may have never happened had it not been for an unusual play earlier in the fifth inning. After the Slaters had scored a run to slice the lead to 4-1, NDGP got two quick outs. Then with runners on first and second, a single forced Jade Hendricks (running for Kristina Langdon) to round third base, but rather than trying to score she stopped at third. Another runner going from second to third got caught in a pickle between second and third forcing Hendricks to run home. Although the throw to the plate beat her, she slid safely under the tag for a run to keep the inning alive.

With the score at 4-2 and two outs, Sarah Harvat

promptly hit a deep drive to centerfield scoring two runs, knotting the score at 4-4 and setting up Carson's two-RBI, tie-breaking single.

Bangor plays Pen Argyl in the season's finale at Bangor Middle School this afternoon.

While Carson's heroics rescued the Slater softball team, a few hundred yards away, Hunter Rydell's single gave Bangor's baseball team a 6-5 win in the bottom of the seventh and final inning.

With the game tied at 1-1, NDGP scored four runs in the top of the fifth to take a 5-1 lead.

Bangor, however, scored three in the bottom of the inning, cutting the lead to 5-4 going to the sixth inning where the Slaters used an unearned run in the bottom of the inning to tie the game at 5-5.

Rein Farensbach reached base in the seventh inning on an error setting the stage for Hunter Rydell's game winning single driving Farensbach home for a 6-5 win.

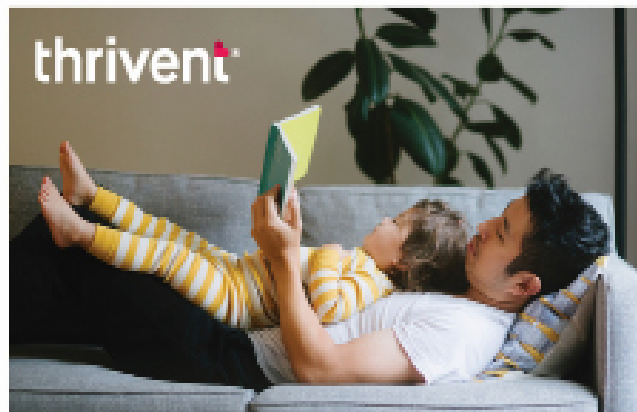

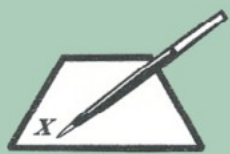

This free community initiative encourages people of all ages and abilities to meet their personal fitness goals.

From May 1 to November 8, the 165-Mile Challenge encourages participants to log 165 miles of exercise, such as walking, hiking, running, biking or paddling on the D& L trails or anywhere they choose.

"Get Your Tail on the Trail" participants register for free as an individual or as part of an organization

and log the miles doing a continuous activity for 10 minutes or more. While the program doesn't require participants to exercise exclusively on the 165-mile D&L Trail, it is a great centerpiece resource. The trail stretches from Wilkes-Barre to Bristol, Pennsylvania.

In addition to the 165-Mile Challenge that runs each May to November, there are special events throughout the year, including bike and hike outings, health fairs, history walks and more. Since we launched in 2013, close to 10,000 participants have logged over 5 million miles. Those who complete the challenge receive a reward. Past rewards have included t-shirts, hats, backpacks, and rain ponchos.

"Our goal is straightforward: To get people outside and get them active," says Kathy Ramson, St. Luke's Network Director for Healthy Living and Chronic Disease. "We want people to be physically active because it is one of the best ways to prevent chronic disease. There's a good deal of data that show that if you exercise 150 minutes a week, you're going to have better health outcomes overall."

Ramson said the program is purposefully simple. "If fitness is complicated, people won't do it," she says. "We make it simple because we want to eliminate the barriers."
