

What Is the True Meaning of Memorial Day? Memorial Day Services began in East Bangor In 1891

Less than half of Americans know the true meaning behind Memorial Day, according to a new survey.

The survey of 2,000 Americans revealed just 43% were aware it's a holiday honoring those who died in service while in the U.S. Armed Forces.

Twenty-eight percent mistakenly believed Memorial Day was a holiday honoring all military veterans who have served in the U.S. Armed Forces — which is actually Veterans Day.

It was revealed to be a common mistake: A third of respondents (36%) admitted to being unsure of the difference between Memorial Day and Veterans Day.

Less than half of Americans know the true meaning behind Memorial Day, according to a new survey.

The survey of 2,000 Americans revealed just 43% were aware it's a holi-

day honoring those who died in service while in the U.S. Armed Forces.

Conducted by OnePoll on behalf of University of Phoenix, the survey tested Americans on their knowledge of the upcoming holiday, which, this year, falls on Monday, May 30.

That's news to some respondents: The survey found less than half (46%) of respondents knew Memorial Day is celebrated on the last Monday of May.

The most common incorrect answer? A fifth (21%) believed Memorial Day falls on the last Sunday of May.

This year's survey expanded on those findings — and revealed respondents were uninformed about more than just the meaning of the holiday.

When asked about the Moment of Remembrance, a moment wherein Americans are asked to pause for a duration of one minute to remember those who have died in U.S. military service, half of those polled hadn't heard of it.

But a third of respondents (35%) were able to select the correct time for when it takes place — 3 p.m. local time on Memorial Day.

Half of the Americans polled had also not heard the term "Gold Star family" — which is a family who has lost a loved one in military service. Once explained, 55% of respondents said they planned to do something

kind for a Gold Star family this Memorial Day. "For many Americans, Memorial Day is a much-needed day off to relax and enjoy their family. It is important to understand that it is also a solemn day of remembrance. For me, as a combat veteran, and for military members and their families, this day holds great significance. Not everyone I served with was fortunate enough to return home," said Brian Ishmael, senior director, University of Phoenix Office of Military and Veteran Affairs and former U.S. Army sergeant.

Although Memorial Day did not become a federal holiday until 1971, it beginnings can be traced to the Civil War and later to the Slate Belt as early as 1891.

A story from the Morning Call about a Memorial Day Ceremony at the East Bangor Cemetery in 1940 mentioned that this was the 49th anniversary of Memorial Day celebrations in East Bangor, meaning the first was held in 1891

While Memorial Day Services are currently held in St. John's Cemetery in Bangor, one of the first Memorial Day services in town was held in the Lutheran grove at the Trinity Lutheran Church on Broadway in 1907. Back in the day, the grove was the site of many community gatherings, including Welsh Day.

The day featured a parade prior from town hall to the grove for an all-day lunch and dinner picnic.

In 1911, Reid Carr, an attorney from New York City spoke at a memorial day celebration in Pen Argyl for one hour talking about soldiers from the Civil War.

In 1923, a group of residents from Roseto and "Bangor Hill" held a Memorial Day Service at Our Lady of Mount Carmel Church.

That same year, Portland residents asked community children to decorate the graves of veterans, hoping this would become a tradition.

In 1938, Lt. Herbert Dietz of Bethlehem dropped a wreath from an airplane on the grave of his friend Lt. Harold Dietz of Bangor in St. John's Cemetery, beginning a 50-year tradition in which Frey, eventually landing by helicopter, presented a wreathe in person.

In 1946, a parade preceded ceremonies at St. Johns. The parade included Bangor Police, the Bangor Band, Boy and Girl Scouts, Son of Veterans, the VFW and American Legion.

Memorial Day ceremonies still occur in St. John's although the parade usually concludes the day's activities.




