Thursday Night, Mostly clear, with a low around 23.



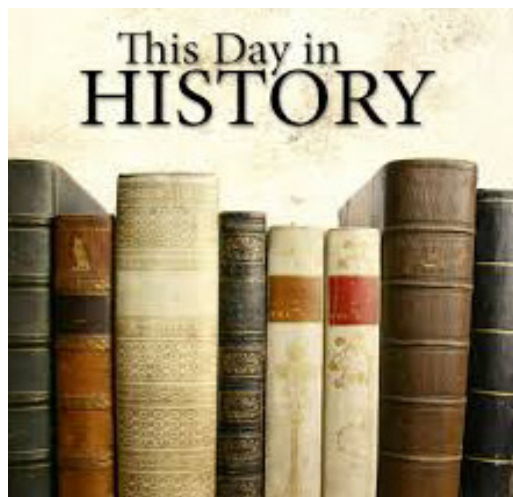
This Day In History

Pope Urban II Orders First Crusade

On November 27, 1095, Pope Urban II makes perhaps the most influential speech of the Middle Ages, giving rise to the Crusades by calling all Christians in Europe to war against Muslims in order to reclaim the Holy Land, with a cry of "Deus vult!" or "God wills it!"

Born Odo of Lagery in 1042, Urban was a protege of the great reformer Pope Gregory VII. Like Gregory, he made internal reform his main focus, railing against simony (the selling of church offices) and other clerical abuses prevalent during the Middle Ages. Urban showed himself to be an adept and powerful cleric, and when he was elected pope in 1088, he applied his statecraft to weakening support for his rivals, notably Clement III.

By the end of the 11th century, the Holy Land—the area now commonly referred to as the Middle East—had become a point of conflict for European Christians.

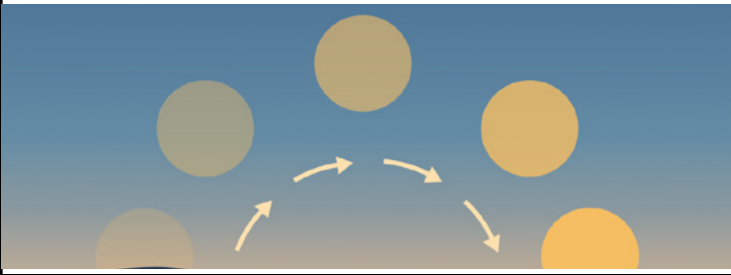

Striba Only 2nd Slater To Rush & Pass for 1,000 Yards in Single Season



Bangor's Eric Striba was only the second player in the 103-year history of Bangor High School football to rush for over 1,000 yards and pass for over 1,000 yards in the same season.

Scott Lavalva was the first to accomplish the feat in 2008.

Striba also moved into fourth place with 122 points in a season and third place in career points with 236.

He is now second in career rushing touchdowns with 38. He is also fifth in career rushing yardage with 2,529.

Pavilion Dedicated to the Late Leslie Couch

When a tree fell during a storm this spring and severely damaged the pavilion at East Bangor Park, little did anyone know how the outcome would play out.

"The whole side was pushed down and just taken out," said event MC and East Bangor Municipal Authority Vice President Russ Stout. "Insurance money would only pay for that damage, but we had the structural damage and engineers here found out all the posts, 18 of the 20, (were damaged). And this (pavilion) is our main source of money coming in."

As word got out about the park pavilion, old timers and people with roots in the town came out and expressed the desire to do what they could to keep their memories alive.

Dan Williams of Extraordinary Concepts stepped up and offered to fix the pavilion and have it ready for July 4, which he did by end of June.

If there was ever any doubt that East Bangor would reconstruct the pavilion, that was all put to rest when it was

learned that former East Bangor resident Leslie Couch, who was later killed in Viet Nam, helped build the original pavilion in 1961.

"When I found out that. We're gonna rebuild," said Stout, setting the dedication in motion of the reconstructed pavilion in Couch's name.

Couch incidentally, is buried in East Bangor Cemetery just across the road from the park in full view of the pavilion.

The 21-year-old East Bangor Marine was killed in action in the Da Nang area during the Viet Nam war. He was the son of Mr. and Mrs. Jack Couch of Hazen Ave.

Pvt. Couch enlisted in the Marines after graduating from Pen Argyl Area High School in 1963. He had been a star tackle on the school's football team. He was attached to Company E, 1st Battalion. Prior to being sent to Viet Nam, he spent his entire time in service at Camp Lejeune, N.C., except for two weeks when he was shipped to Santo Domingo during the rioting there

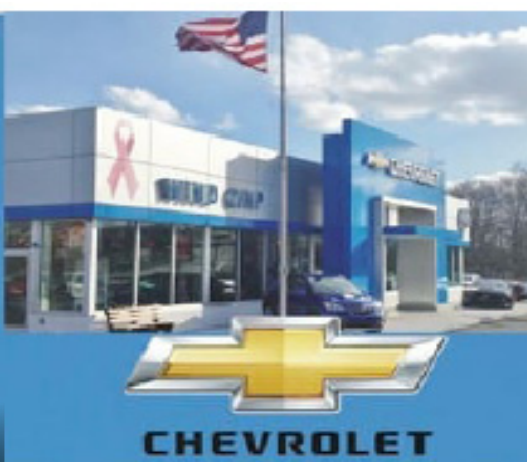
