

# Slaters Win 99th Rivalry Game 50-7

The 99th meeting of the storied Bangor-Pen Argyl game had all the makings of an upset until the Slaters' Joe Shrader (number 7 pictured at right) ran 95 yards to score on an interception with only 35 seconds left



in the first half. What was beginning to look like a shoot-out turned into a 50-7 rout.

Until the pick-six, the Knights had rallied from a 14-0 deficit, cutting the lead to 14-7 on a 13-yard touchdown pass from Anderson Dear to Gabe Hahn. When Bangor failed to respond, the Knights were on the move again. Thanks to a pair of big Bangor penalties and the passing of Dear, the Knights were in position to score again with less than a minute to play in the first half on the strength of the a 17-yard pass to Connor Fehr. With a first-and-goal at the five Pen Argyl had plenty of time to score at least a field goal. Shrader, however, picked off a pass in the left flat and rambled down the left sideline, shaking a tackler at the Knights' 30 and going in for the score.

Joe Genteel ran in for a two-pointer giving Bangor a 22-7 edge at halftime.

With momentum on their side, the Slaters' defense did not give up a first down in the second half after surrendering 10 in the first half and committing an equal number of penalties.

Meanwhile, Garrett DeBoer scored on runs of 61 and 54 yards in the third quarter for a 36-7 lead. Brad Kane scored on a 26-yard pass from Bo Meyers in the final quarter and freshman Kael Godshalk scored on a one-yard run. Derek Lasher connected on four second half PATS for a 50-7 final.

DeBoer carried the ball 10 times, despite playing with an injured hand, for 169 yards and two touchowns while Shrader carried 10 times for 100 yard. He and DeBoer were named co-MVPs for Bangor while Tadd Barr earned MVP honors for the Knights.

Bangor's Seth Diorio who had many tackles and an interception was named Lineman of the game presented to him by Eric Sampson.

## Other Game Take-Aways:

-Pen Argyl still leads series 50-45-1.

-Second time in series that the winning team scored 50 points or more. Pen Argyl scored 51 in 2006.

-Shrader's interception was the second longest in school history. The record is held by Nick Corkins who ran 103 yards with an interception versus Catasauqua in 1971

-Bangor was penalized 12 times, 10 in the first half.

-Pen Argyl ended the season at 3-7.

-Bangor (6-4) won their third straight game and will play in the District XI AAAA tourney vs Pottsville at Pottsville Saturday November 3.





# **Prescription Coverage Increases**

Legislation to expand eligibility for the state's PACENET prescription drug coverage program passed the House last week and is moving through the state Senate. Up to 17,000 Pennsylvania seniors are expected to benefit from this expansion.

House Bill 270 would increase the annual maximum income limits in the PACENET program to \$27,500 for a single person and to \$35,500 for a married couple. Current maximum income requirements for the PACENET program, which covers those individuals with incomes exceeding PACE maximums, are \$23,500 for a single individual and \$31,500 for a married couple annually.

Additionally, the bill would allow two new pharmacy-based programs to be developed under the PACE program to assist seniors in monitoring their prescription drug usage.

This eligibility expansion would be the first since 2004, and it is funded by proceeds from the Pennsylvania Lottery.

# **New Law Enhances Training**

To help ensure the state's animal cruelty laws are enforced in the fairest way possible, legislation has been signed into law to strengthen the training and oversight of Humane Society police officers.

Act 77 of 2018 increased initial and annual training hours for Humane Society police officers, and requires the training to include the proper procedure to file citations and warrants, including when and how to contact other law enforcement.

Other provisions of the new law require training in farm operations and biosecurity, including at least one on-site visit to a working commercial farm operation. Any organization that employs Humane Society police officers will be subject to the state's Right-to-Know Law.

Additionally, a Humane Society police officer must be a resident of Pennsylvania. If the appointment of a Humane Society police officer is revoked in one county, it would be revoked in all counties.

# **PennDOT Customer Care Website**

To make it easier to report concerns on state roads, PennDOT has modernized its online customer care center. The new website will include new mapping capabilities, optional photo uploads and a mobile-friendly interface.

Concerns are sorted into several categories: road or bridge conditions; removing debris from a roadway; traffic, signs or signals; ongoing roadwork or projects; or general questions and concerns. Motorists are asked to be as specific as possible when providing locations of concerns. Motorists should report the county, municipality, street name and state route number, which can be found on small black and white signs posted along state highways. In addition, a description of any familiar landmarks are helpful for PennDOT to locate the problem area.

As of Sept. 30, the previous Customer Care Center had nearly 45,000 concerns submitted this year, according to PennDOT, with more than 96 percent of those concerns being resolved.

# Giving the Gift of Life

Legislation that would help encourage organ and tissue donation in Pennsylvania is now on the governor's desk.

Senate Bill 180, which unanimously passed the House last week, would expand the list of those persons authorized to decide on behalf of a decedent whether his or her organs are donated.

Among other provisions, it would also permit a minimally invasive blood or tissue test to be conducted to determine the suitability of a donor; call for education regarding organ and tissue donation and transplantation for high school students, as well as nursing and medical students; and increase the voluntary contribution made by citizens from \$1 to \$3 for driver's license and vehicle registration renewals.

Currently, more than 800 Pennsylvanians are waiting for an organ transplant.

# **Crack Down on Hazing**

Legislation that seeks to better ensure the safety of students on college campuses by cracking down on hazing passed the House this

Senate Bill 1090 is a comprehensive overhaul of the state's antihazing law to give law enforcement better tools to prosecute hazingrelated activities and to encourage those nearby to call for assistance for someone who may need help.

Specifically, the bill would increase penalties for those involved in hazing; require schools to have policies and reporting procedures in place to stop hazing; and ensure that parents and students are provided with information related to the issue. The legislation also would establish clear parameters on hazing for organizations such as fraternities and sororities.

The legislation is named in memory of Tim Piazza, a Penn State student who died as a result of hazing in 2017 and was denied medical care for hours. The measure now heads back to the Senate for concurrence.






