






Severe weather & flood risk Thursday

Philadelphia/Mount Holly

ISSUED: 4:50 AM Wednesday, October 12, 2022

- A strong cold front will cross the region Thursday night.
- Widespread showers and scattered thunderstorms are expected ahead of the front.
- A few thunderstorms may produce damaging winds late Thursday into Thursday evening.





- Some thunderstorms may also produce locally heavy rain leading to some instances of flooding.
- The strongest storms are expected primarily from I-95 north and west.
- Storms should clear the area by Friday morning.

Scientists Say One of Saturn's Moons Could Contain Life

Saturn's sixth largest moon, Enceladus, could contain life, a new study reveals.

Scientists have found that Enceladus' ocean is likely rich in phosphorus, a key component for life.

Phosphorus, in the form of phosphates, is essential for the creation of DNA and RNA, energy-carrying molecules, cell membranes, bones and teeth in people and animals, and even the sea's microbiome of plankton.

"Enceladus is one of the prime targets in humanity's search for life in our solar system," said Dr. Christopher Glein, a leading expert in extraterrestrial oceanography at Southwest Research Institute, and member of the team.

"In the years since NASA's Cassini spacecraft visited the Saturn system, we have been repeatedly blown away by the discoveries made possible by the collected data."

The Cassini spacecraft discovered water under the moon's icy surface, opening up the idea that it could sustain life.

Scientists are now going beyond water and looking for specific molecules that can support life.

"The quest for extraterrestrial habitability in the solar system has shifted focus, as we now look for the building blocks for life, including organic molecules, ammonia, sulphur-bearing compounds as well as the chemical energy needed to support life," Glein said. "Phosphorus presents an interesting case because previous work suggested that it might be scarce in the ocean of Enceladus, which would dim the prospects for life."

Glein added: "What we have learned is that the plume contains almost all the basic requirements of life as we know it.



In fact, according to a study done by the University of Pennsylvania a few years ago, only one out of four Americans could name all three branches of the federal government.

Local Girl Scout leader, Jamie Goffredo is hoping to make that chore a bit easier by encouraging her troop members to earn their democracy badges. She brought three troops recently to Roseto Ball Park: a troop of daisies, which consists of first graders, a troop of brownies, which consists of second graders, and a troop of juniors which consists of fourth graders to participate in group discussions with local government officials.

This project, "is an overview of local government, state government, (the) country's legislative branch, executive branch and the judicial branch," Goffredo said. Tillman told the girls about her job as mayor and how borough council works in addition to other services provided by the borough.

"You also have garbage collection," the Mayor said. "(What) would it be like if all of your garbage stayed at your house. So, it's our job to make sure that we have people that will come every week ... So those are things that our town makes sure that we do that benefits you. This is how a democracy works."

"I thought it was really interesting," Mayor Tillman said of her experience with scouts. "... I

think it's good because too often I think people wait till they become the adult and then they finally realize what government is about, and all those years that I wasted because I just kind of blew it off. It's really good to get the understanding now, instead of waiting (until) you're 30 years old, it's almost too late."


