Flash Flood Watch Continues More Heavy Rain Forecast Today

The Flash Flood Watch continues for portions of southern New Jersey and in the following counties in Pennsylvania: Carbon, Eastern Montgomery, **Lehigh, Lower Bucks, Monroe, Northampton**, Philadelphia, Upper Bucks, and Western Montgomery through this afternoon.

Rain is forecast all day today. Widespread rain totals of 2 to 4 inches are likely within the watch area, with locally higher amounts possible.

Flash flooding of creeks, streams, urban areas, and areas of poor drainage is possible with the heaviest rain. **At 6:00am in the Slate Belt 2.15 inches of rain have fallen since last night.** See additional information on page two below.
