## Slaters Win 102nd Rivalry Game 53-0

Bangor, led by game MVP Kael Godshalk's four touchdowns, scored a convincing 53-0 win over Pen Argyl in their 102nd rivalry game despite a cold, biting wind and drizzle.
Although the weather probably annoyed spectators more than the players, the NWS forecast indicated the possibility of heavy rains forcing game officials around the area to change the game time to an earlier start or another day.
Starting at 5:30 rather than 7, the Slaters received the opening kickoff only to fumble the return, giving the Knights an early break.
Given the nature of the historic rivalry, one may have thought that the early turnover was a portent of things to come. Fortunately for Bangor, ghosts of prior upsets were not about to haunt the Slaters on this Halloween weekend.
Bangor stopped the Knights and took over, eventually scoring on a run by Eric Striba, Striba also ran for a two-pointer and an 8-0 lead with 3:48 left in the opening period.
In the second quarter, Striba ran 15 yards for another score and added another two-pointer for a 16-0 lead with $8: 14$ to play in the first half. Near the end of the second quarter, Godshalk ran 30 yards for a touchdown, increasing his yearly rushing total to over 1,000 yards. Paul Burkholder caught a pass for a two-point conversion and a 24-0 lead with 3:28 to play.
Shortly before the end of the half, the Slaters blocked a punt. But with only seconds to play, Striba's long pass was intercepted by the Knights' Damian Tyminski as time ran out.
In the second half, Godshalk scored on three runs and Ashton Kluska ran in for the final score with 2:57 left for a 53-0 final.
Bangor ended regular season play with a 6-4 record and will likely play in an Eastern Conference game next weekend.

## Extra Points:

- Pen Argyl leads the series 52-46-4
- Bangor has scored 349 points this year for a 34.9 ppg average which is one of the best in school history.
- Pen Argyl ended the season at 0-10 for their first winless season since 1992 when the Knights were 0-11 under coach John Piper. With a team rich in talented underclassmen, the Knights will get back on the winning track next year.
- Coach Paul Reduzzi now has a 9-3 overall record in rivarly games, second only to the late Paul Farnan's 16-6-1 record. Eight of those wins were at Pen Argyl where he was tied with Elwood Petchel who was 8-4 in rivalry games.
- Bangor will play Bethlehem Catholic, Saucon Valley or Lewisburg in the Eastern Conference Championship. The Eastern conference does not have any qualifying games leading to the title game like they had in the past.
