

Earning the rank of Life Scout is an important milestone. The scout is encouraged to think about the symbol of the heart. Historically in scouting, it was a fitting symbol of health and

fitness, but it also represents the spirit of caring and giving that is behind the Eagle Scout service project.

Service to other people is what scouting is all about. In many ways, the service project reflects who the scout is as a youth leader. The result should be of significant impact in the community to be special, and should represent the scout's very best effort.

> Telepo's service project was the recent refurbishing of the front entrance of the Dyle E. Bray Post Home Association formerly known as the Bangor VFW. Telepo concentrated his efforts on installing eight decorative poll wraps around the support beams of the building. He also made and painted two new benches near the front doors by re-purposing the older ones.

Finally, he posted a new welcome sign near the entrance to complete his Eagle Scout Project which visually enhances the appearance of the front entrance to the building

"I can't thank you guys enough," Telepo said during his Eagle Scout ceremony. "When I started the project, I knew I had a lot of time but as time went on and COVID hit, I realized that I had less and less time."

"(With) pushing from my parents, and my fellow scouts as well. I'm just blessed to have people around me back here."



Becoming an Eagle is not automatic, nor does one become an Eagle with a snap of the fingers or the wink of an eye. It takes time, hard work, perseverance, and dedication to get there. Scouts are required to earn all the ranks in order, starting with Scout. The following is a list of the activities the Scout will complete on their journey to Eagle Scout:

- Be active in the troop for at least six months as a Life Scout
- Show dedication to Scout Oath and Scout Law3
- Provide references from family, work, church, and other community groups
- Earn 21 merit badges
- Serve a minimum of six months in a leadership position

BANGOR STUNS NORTHWESTERN 27-21

It's that time of the year when football teams need crucial wins to stay in the playoff hunt. To do that they need big plays at the right time.

While the Slaters' vaunted rushing attack (37-236) was in good form Friday in New Tripoli versus powerful Northwestern, it was Bangor's defense that made the difference cashing in on a pair of crucial turnovers, one for a touchdown and the other to seal a hard-fought win.

The Slaters which hadn't beaten the Tigers since a 22-20 win in 2017, scored first and never trailed improving their record to 6-2.

Bangor scored first after stopping Northwestern at the their own 25. From here, Bangor drove 75 yards in 14 plays, scoring on Eric Striba's 2-yard run. M.J. Siu's PAT gave the Slaters a 7-0 lead. It was reported that Bangor converted two third downs and a fourth down in the series consuming more than seven minutes.

The Tigers came back with a nine-play, 64-yard drive finished by Dalton Clymer with a 6-yard scoring run to tie the score at 7-7.

Moments later, the Slaters' speedy Noah Hillis put Bangor back on top with a 61-yard run. Siu's PAT gave the Slaters a 14-7 lead. Clymer then evened the score after a ten-play drive to make the score 14-14 at half.

That score held through the third quarter as a game filled with offense became a defensive tug of war.

The Slaters' Alex Farensbach, however, broke the deadlock when he picked up a Tiger fumble and raced 64 yards giving Bangor a 21-14 lead after Siu's third consecutive PAT with 11:48 left in the game.

After the Tigers evened the score at 21-21, Striba's 3-yard touchdown run with 3 minutes, 20 seconds left gave the Slaters the lead. Striba then sealed the deal when he hit Tigers' QB Cade Christopher forcing a fumble that Riley Stapp pounced on with 44 seconds left to preserve a 27-21 win.

Bangor (6-2) will host Blue Mountain (5-3) next week and will then close out the regular season in the 103rd renewal of the Slate Belt Rivalry at Pen Argyl. Depending on circumstances the Slaters may then qualify for the District 4A playoffs.



In fact, according to a study done by the University of Pennsylvania a few years ago, only one out of four Americans could name all three branches of the federal government.

Local Girl Scout leader, Jamie Goffredo is hoping to make that chore a bit easier by encouraging her troop members to earn their democracy badges. She brought three troops recently to Roseto Ball Park: a troop of daisies, which consists of first graders, a troop of brownies, which consists of second graders, and a troop of juniors which consists of fourth graders to participate in group discussions with local government officials.

This project, "is an overview of local government, state government, (the) country's legislative branch, executive branch and the judicial branch," Goffredo said. "So, by the time they are finished, they'll know more about how government works, including government within their town or city and the whole

Tillman told the girls about her job as mayor and how borough council works in addition to other services provided by the borough.

"You also have garbage collection," the Mayor said. "(What) would it be like if all of your garbage stayed at your house. So, it's our job to make sure that we have people that will come every week ... So those are things that our town makes sure that we do that benefits you. This is how a democracy works."

"I thought it was really interesting," Mayor Tillman said of her experience with scouts. "... I

think it's good because too often I think people wait till they become the adult and then they finally realize what government is about, and all those years that I wasted because I just kind of blew it off. It's really good to get the understanding now, instead of waiting (until) you're 30 years old, it's almost too late."
