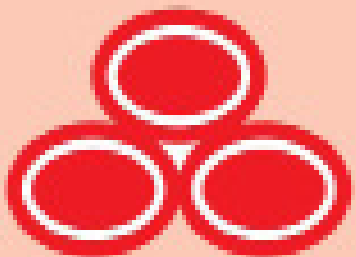

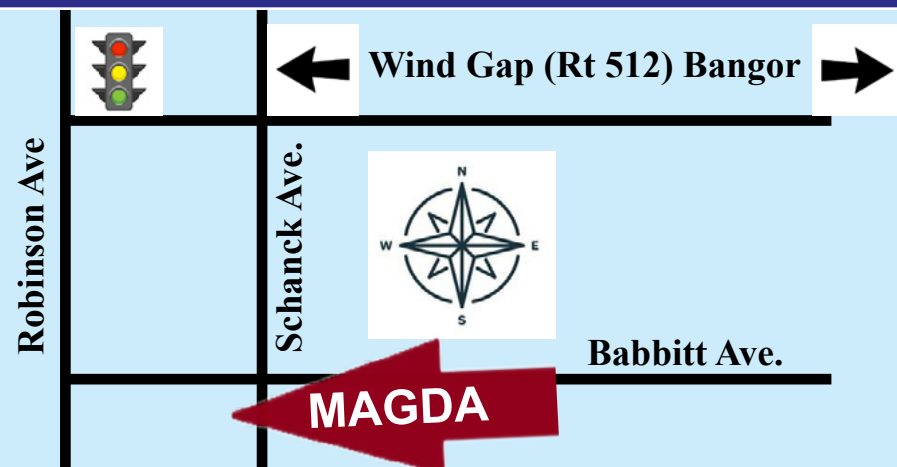

BHS Alum Carl Hoffman An All-Sport Great

Like other athletes of his age, BHS alum Carl Hoffman did not have the opportunity to play in the Slate Belt Rivalry. Although there was very little mention of Hoffman in the media of the early 20th century, much less his connection to the Slate Belt, he still had the wherewithal to be a three-sport standout in college, and had the good fortune to have caught Hall-of-Famer Lefty Grove during his minor league baseball career.

Hoffman was born in 1896 and was raised at 335 Market Street in Bangor with his parents, a sister Mabel and brother Raymond (1927 BHS Head football coach) just a few blocks from the Kichline family at 18 South Second St., which produced sons Roy, Ronald and Ellwood, all contemporaries of Hoffman.

Hoffman graduated from Bangor High School in 1913 and went to Albright College following in the footsteps of his sister Mabel. He was quarterback for the football team with Albright, a catcher for the baseball team, and as a guard, the leading scorer on the basketball team. He once made 19 free throws in a 1917 game versus Moravian when the rules allowed a team to choose a free throw shooter for all free throws, and who was usually the best free throw shooter on the team.

Player and team statistics were seldom reported in the media, if in fact, teams even kept statistics other than scoring, making it difficult to report more pertinent information.

In a 1915 football game, Albright was crushed 54-0 by Ursinus led by fullback Ronald Kichline who was Hoffman's neighbor and teammate at Bangor. Closer to home, Hoffman scored three touchdowns in a 27-0 win by the Bangor A.A. over Nazareth in 1921.

The November 12, 1921 edition of the Morning Call read, "Hoffman, a former Albright College star, was easily the feature of the game. Playing right halfback for Bangor, he time and again crashed through the line for long gains....."

Hoffman's career at Albright was cut short by World War I where he served as a candidate in Officers' Training School for the Infantry.

After he was discharged from the military in 1919, and even though he hadn't

completed his final year at Albright, he took a job as head football coach and math teacher at Latrobe High School in Western Pennsylvania, a member of the prestigious WPIAL.

Although Coach Hoffman didn't get the recognition of Latrobe native son Arnold Palmer or Rolling Rock Beer, he quickly caught the attention of Latrobe sports fans when his 1919 team compiled a 6-0-2 record. Latrobe opened the season with a 76-0 win over Windber. Scoreless ties with Johnstown and Greenburg were the only low spots of a season in which Hoffman's team outscored its opponents 187-6.



Despite the prospects of a successful coaching career, Hoffman left Latrobe in the spring of 1920 to play Class D baseball with the Martinsburg Mountaineers of the Blue Ridge League in West Virginia. There he played in 62 games, batting .225 with two home runs. He also had the honor of playing with and catching Lefty Grove, an eventual 300-game winner and Major League Baseball Hall of Famer.

After his time in minor league baseball, Hoffman's life took another turn in the fall of 1921 when he enrolled in Juniata College to finish his senior year in college and resume his athletic career, coached by friend and former teammate, Ronald Kichline.

Hoffman picked up his athletic career at Juniata where he left off at Albright. According to a story in the Harrisburg Telegraph from 1922, "Hoffman is one of the best-known college athletes in this section of the country. He played last season with the football team and had a brilliant record as a member of the basketball squad. As a member of the baseball squad (he) proved one of the best backstops in the history of Juniata baseball. For years to come they will talk about his long hits in the pinches, his deadly throws to second, and his splendid record at capturing foul balls and in preventing passed balls."

After graduating from Juniata, Hoffman was hired to coach football and basketball at Juniata, replacing Kichline who stayed on as head baseball coach. Hoffman was also hired as a mathematics instructor at Juniata's school academy.

In his Juniata football coaching debut in the fall of 1922, his team faced Albright coached by his former teammate at Albright, and now brother-in-law Harry "Haps" Benfer. Benfer, however, didn't show any mercy, handing Hoffman a 34-0 loss.

Juniata lost to Geneva the following week before his team defeated Ursinus 18-12 and Drexel 46-6. The team closed the with a 46-0 loss to Thiel for a final record of 3-4-0.

Hoffman's basketball team went 11-10. Those 11 wins were a seasonal high for the next 30 years.

Just prior to his stint at Juniata, Hoffman married Ruth Varner from Somerset, PA and a graduate of Albright College. At the end of his first year as a Juniata coach, Hoffman resigned from Juniata and moved to Somerset where he went into in the lumber, oil, and banking businesses from 1923 to 1946.

Following in his father's footsteps, he was later elected as a Republican to the U.S. House of Representatives Seventy-ninth Congress to fill the vacancy caused by the death of J. Buell Snyder and served from May 21, 1946, to January 3, 1947.

Rivalry Game 104 Set For Friday at Bangor

The Bangor -Pen Argyl football rivalry, which officially began in 1922, can actually be traced to a first-known encounter in 1910 won by Bangor, 12-0. It's also likely that other games were played before and after 1910, however, there is no known documentation to support that conclusion.

Very little is known about the 1910 game since newspaper stories of that era contain very little information about local high school games.

For now, the details of that game are unknown and will likely remain so for a long time.

We do, however, know the names of some players that could have participated in the that first game. It's also fair to say, based on some anecdotal accounts, that not all players were students. "Ringers" as they were known, most likely worked in the quarries and also played for the community and high school football teams.

Carl Hoffman and Ronald Kichline most likely played for Bangor and Harry "Gook" Saltern for Pen Argyl.

No information is available about their exploits in high school, but their accomplishments in college suggests these men would have excelled in high School.

We will present stories about these men this week in the lead-up to the 104th rivalry game.

Hoffman was a star quarterback for three years at Albright and one year at Juniata. He also was a college coach and played minor league baseball.

Kichline excelled as a running back for Ursinus and also coached college football for 15 years. Read more this week.

Study Reveals Why Many Kids Are Quitting Sports

Researchers: “significant correlation” between screen time, body image, and ditching sports.

Youngsters are quitting sports over body image issues, gender biases and social media, reveals a new study.

American researchers found a “significant correlation” between screen time, body image, and ditching sports.

Many youngsters said they abandoned exercise because they felt they didn’t look as good as the athletes on social media, and don’t perform as well.

Previous studies have shown 70 percent of children have ditched sports by the time they hit 13 years old.

By 14, girls start quitting at twice the rate of boys.

To determine why they may feel negatively about physical activities, researchers from University of Central Florida College of Medicine (UCFCM) surveyed 70 current or past athletes from ages eight to 18.

They found some kids abandon sports because they struggle with the competitive pressure of the sport, and girls were particularly prone to quitting because of competition.

Having issues with their coach was another key reason for leaving.

Parents must understand the impact a coach has and ensure they have proper training to foster a positive sports environment, they added.

The team also discovered those who were less confident in their sporting ability ranked

Professor Cassidy Foley Davelaar said: “Youth sports participation sets up children for a lifetime of healthy habits. Kids who participate in youth sports have improved cardiovascular fitness, muscular strength and endurance, and a healthy weight.

“Parents need to know what drives kids to quit sports so they can support their children’s physical and mental health.

“Coaches and parents need to know that their words and actions can influence kids’ participation in sports.

“By being mindful to not place any importance on looking a certain way, adults can encourage a more supportive, inclusive and welcome sports environment among children of all abilities.”

She added: “We hope these findings will reveal the drivers of sports attrition so that adults can create a sports environment that brings joy and participation back to the game.”

Study: When You Snooze, You Don't Lose

Hitting The Snooze Button Will Make Some People Sharper.

When you snooze, you don't actually lose, according to a new study.

Hitting the snooze button in the morning and nodding off again won't improve your mood when you get up but will make some people sharper.

Scientists believe this is because it prevents waking directly from REM or slow-wave sleep, according to their study published in the Journal of Sleep Research.

Surprisingly, although most people said they snoozed because they were tired or in a bad mood on waking, going back to sleep again had no effect on this.

Dr. Tina Sundelin from Stockholm University said: "The findings indicate that there is no reason to stop snoozing in the morning if you enjoy it, at least not for snooze times around 30 minutes.

"In fact, it may even help those with morning drowsiness to be slightly more awake once they get up."

Snoozing resulted in about six minutes of lost sleep but it prevented waking from slow-wave sleep.

There were no clear effects of snoozing on stress hormone levels, morning sleepiness, mood, or overnight sleep structure.

They also looked at 1,732 adults' morning waking habits, with 69 percent saying they used the snooze function or set multiple alarms at least sometimes.

In those who snoozed, the average time spent snoozing per morning was 22 minutes, ranging from one to 180 minutes.

Snoozers tended to be younger than non-snoozers and were more likely to be evening types.

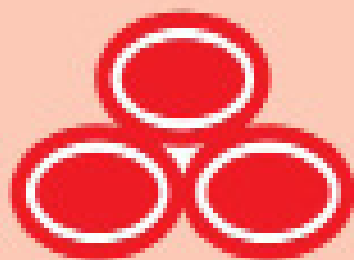
Morning drowsiness and shorter sleep were also more common in those who snoozed.

The most commonly reported reason for snoozing was 'feeling too tired to wake up' (25 percent) followed by 'it feels good' (17 percent) and wanting 'to wake up more slowly/softly'.

Regular snoozers tended to feel more mentally drowsy upon waking, which may be down to the fact that they are younger and go to bed later than those who never snooze.

They may need more time to ward off the effects of sleep inertia, and snoozing may be a potential way of doing this, considering the cognitive improvements.

Even though participants felt equally sleepy upon waking in both conditions, they performed better



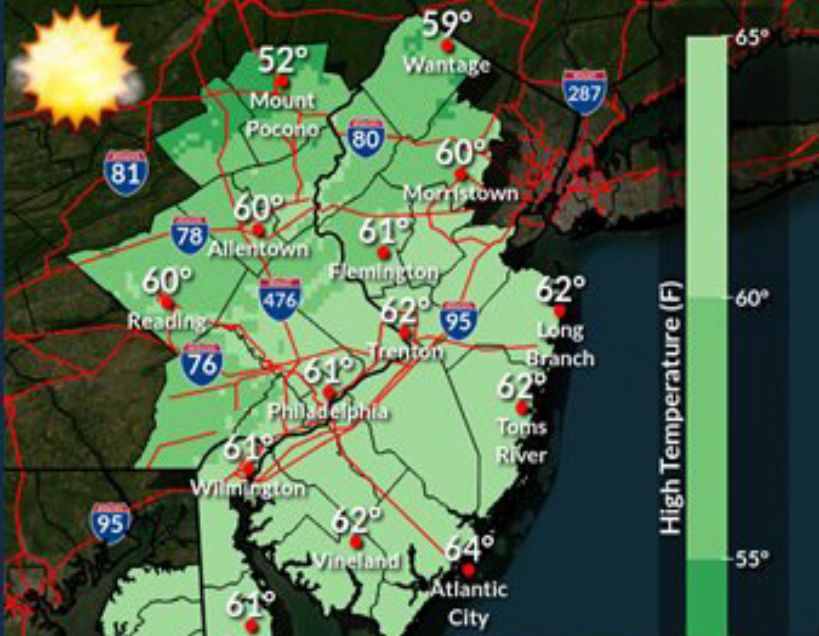

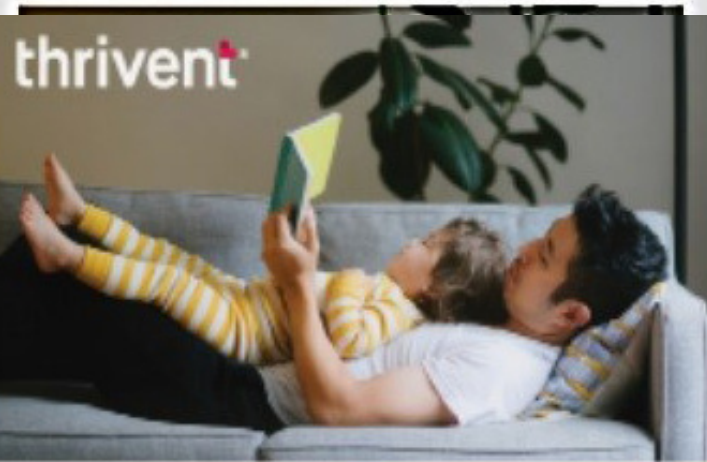

Climate Change Helps Make Better Wine

Warm Summers And Wet Winters Perfect Combo For Growing Good Grapes: New Study.

Climate change could make better wine, suggests new research.

Warm summers and wet winters are the perfect combo for growing good grapes, according to the study.

And climate change could make the perfect conditions more frequent, likely improving the quality of wine in Bordeaux.

University of Oxford researchers compared 50 years of wine critic scores for Bordeaux bottles with the weather in the region that year.

Wines from the area in southwest France appear to have improved in quality between 1950 and 2020.

The team found high-quality wine was grown in cooler, wetter winters and warmer, wetter springs. As well as hot, dry summers and cool, dry autumns.

Andrew Wood, University of Oxford, said: "Weather drives wine quality and wine taste.

"We found evidence that temperature and precipitation effects occur throughout the year—from bud break, while the grapes are growing and maturing, during harvesting, and even overwinter when the plant is dormant.

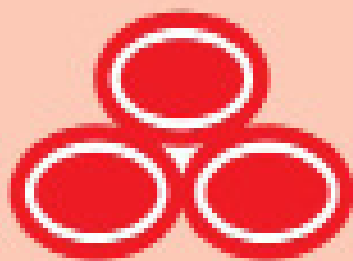
"Perennial crops like grapes are there all the time, and so things that happen outside of the growing season can also impact the wine.

"The trend, whether that's driven by the preferences of wine critics or the general population, is that people generally prefer stronger wines which age for longer and give you richer, more intense flavors, higher sweetness, and lower acidity.

"And with climate change—generally, we are seeing a trend across the world that with greater warming, wines are getting stronger.

"With the predicted climates of the future, given that we are more likely to see these patterns of warmer weather and less rainfall during the summer and more rainfall during the winter, the wines are likely to continue to get better into the future.

"The problem in scenarios where it gets really hot is water. If plants don't have enough, they eventually fail, and when they fail, you lose everything.
