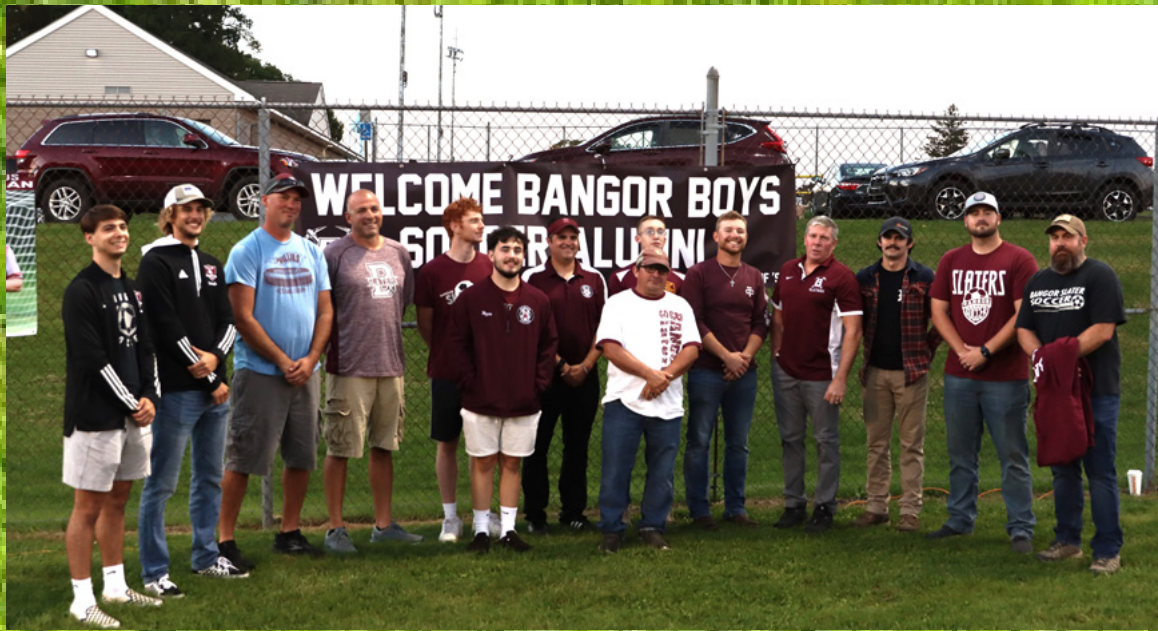

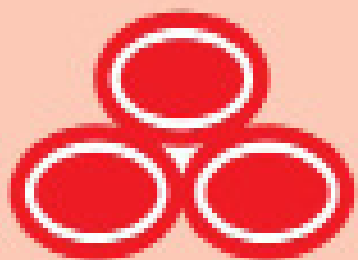

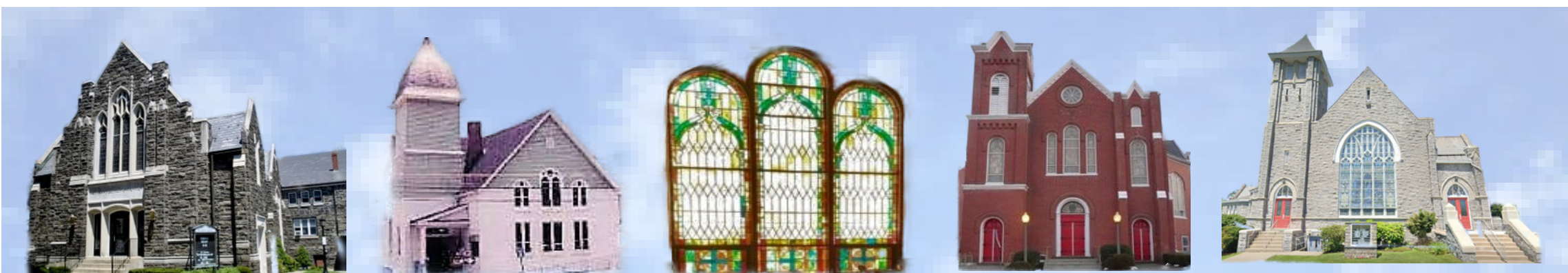

Solar Eclipse

On Oct. 14, 2023, an annular solar eclipse will cross North, Central, and South America and will be visible in parts of the United States. You'll be able to see a partial eclipse from the Nurture Nature Center at 518 Northampton St, Easton. An annular solar eclipse happens when the Moon passes between the Sun and Earth, but when it's at the farthest point from Earth. This is the last annular solar eclipse that will be visible from the United States until June 21, 2039.

*During an annular eclipse, it is never safe to look directly at the Sun without specialized eye protection designed for solar viewing.

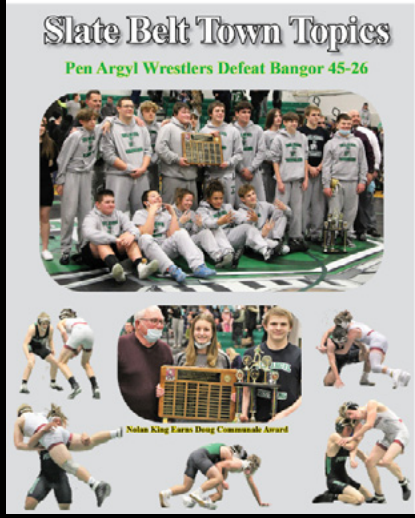
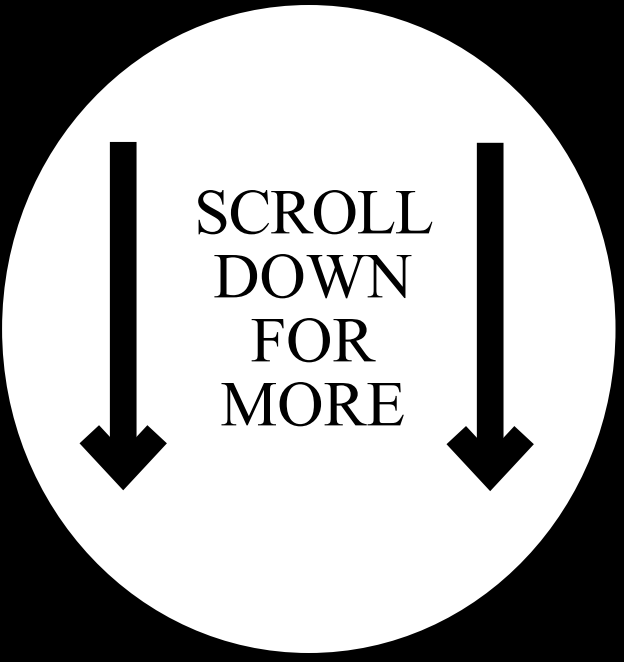
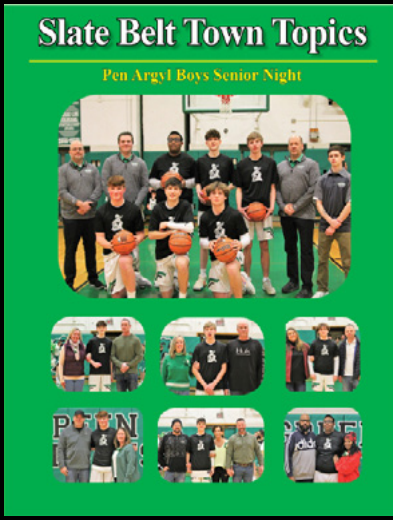
