Labor Day Celebration of 1925 Made Headlines

The 1925 Pen Argyl Labor Celebration was a notable event, but not for band concerts, food, speakers, baseball, baby parades or greased pig contests. Rather, it made headlines because of a group of 53 visitors who took part in the Labor Day Parade,

Well known politicians, famous people or a nationally known band could also have made headlines, but it was the 53 members of Klu Klux Klan that paraded on Pennsylvania Avenue in their white robes that made a memorable day for all the wrong reasons.

The KKK, as most know, is among other things, a white supremacist organization bent on discriminating against people of color and certain ethnic groups.

If their appearance in the parade would have been just about making a statement and leaving town, it would have soon been forgotten. The Klan, however, had other ideas.

The KKK was on the rise in the mid-1920s after keeping a low profile for several years. They wanted to grow their organization by re-establishing the Klan in other areas. According to Wikipedia, they wanted to make roots in towns with a strong protestant background. Pen Argyl was just what they were looking for.

However, they were not pleased with their showing in Pen Argyl on Labor Day and made arrangements to have a picnic a few weeks later

on September 26 at Weona Park. Klan members most likely from Washington, New Jersey and Bangor which, according to the Morning Call had 600 KKK members, most likely fueled the plan.

The day of the Klan picnic, the Pen Argyl band led a white-hooded group to Weona Park where a supper was served by the Ladies of the Weona Park Improvement League to about 200 Klan members, of which about half took part in the parade to the park. After hearing a few speeches, the gathering ended with a fireworks display.

Again, the Klan was disappointed with the small turnout, however, they eventually moved Klan headquarters from Bangor to an unknown location in Pen Argyl.

On New Year's Eve 1925, they burned crosses at the foot off the mountain to celebrate the beginning of 1926. Dr. Bruce Lehman of Scranton later gave a lecture entitled "A Mans Man" on behalf of the KKK in April 1926 at the Liberty Theater. They also held an a meeting in Wind Gap, but the Klan was never as strong as it was in Nazareth and Bethlehem.

As local interest in the Klan continued to decline the only significant news in 1927 was a "huge" KKK rally held in East Bangor in July with hundreds of Klansman in full regalia and entertainment by the East Bangor Band. There also was a meeting of KKK in Pen Argyl September 1927 attended by a "large crowd."

By 1928, however, local interest in the KKK had all but vanished.

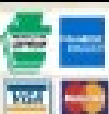

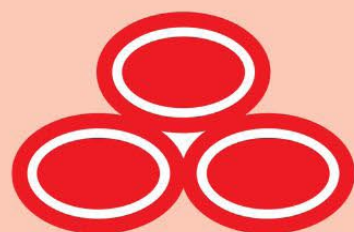
